IT is now five years since the first Penguin Book of English Short Stories appeared and during that time companion volumes containing French, Italian and American stories have appeared. Their publication has demonstrated that, far from continuing its supposed decline, the short story is enjoying a revival all the more encouraging when viewed against the gloom surrounding the future of the literary novel.

The first Penguin Book of English Short Stories set out to survey the history of the genre in its present form and inevitably the need for compression made the choice difficult. I am grateful therefore that this volume allows me to widen the range of authors representative of the best of English short story writing and at the same time to bring the selection forward in time so that it includes more writers who are still at the height of their powers.
