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英语正误详解词典

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前　　言

一、编写这本《英语正误详解词典》的目的,在于帮助已有一定英语基础的学生和自学者提高识别正误英语的能力,掌握常用词汇和句型的用法,从而能够以正确无误的英语表达自己的意思。

二、词典中所收例句,主要来自英语专业各年级的词汇练习,其次是高考、托福考试、自学考试和英语等级考试试卷中的词汇部分。取舍问题概以是否属于中国学生学英语最常出现的错误为标准,主要收录具有普遍性的常见错误,予以改正和解释。

三、每一词条均由〔误〕、〔正〕、〔译文〕、〔解释〕四项组成。〔误〕:常见误句举例;〔正〕:改正后的句子;〔译文〕:根据正句译成的汉语;〔解释〕对误句中的错误进行分析和讲解。需要说明的是,〔误〕中所列举的有很大一部分是词汇和短语用法上的错误。这中间包括为数不少的同义词和近义词的比较。当然,绝大部分的比较都是正误分明、界线清晰的,但也有极少数的情形,难免仁者见仁,智者见智,就连某些语法问题,也有尚在争议,各执一词的。对于这些,我们不愿回避,希望提出来讨论。但词典的体例,是以〔误〕提出问题进行讨论的,这就不得不把一些“不妥”、“欠妥”(不是绝对错误)乃至一些有争议的用法列入〔误〕中以便讨论。凡遇这种情形,都在〔解释〕中作了充分说明。所以就这类〔误〕句而言,究竟是否错误或者误到何等程度,以及存在何种争议,概以〔解释〕为准。

四、词典共收词条四千条,按字母顺序排列。通常是一词一条,但重点词汇(即较易用错的词汇)中的每一单词分为数个或数

十个词条讲解用法,每一词条讲解该词汇用法上的一个方面。凡分为多条讲解的词汇,都在词条右上角用数字标明次序。如: before¹, before²... before⁵; like¹, like²... like¹⁵等。

五、上述重点词汇一词数条或数十条,在排列次序上的原则是先易后难,层层深入。以 would 为例,这个单词共分 16 条,其中 would¹至 would⁴ 讲 would 与时态相关的一些用法; would⁵ 至 would⁷ 讲口语中常用的 would like 的用法及其答语; would⁸ 至 would¹¹讲 would rather 的用法,这四个 would rather 也按难易程度排列, would¹¹讲的是 would rather have done sth. 这一结构的用法; would¹²至 would¹⁵讲 would 与 should 的对比; would¹⁶讲 would 作“过去常常”解时,与 used to 的比较。有时,一连两条讲解同一词汇用法上的同一个方面,这往往是重点中的重点,有意识地予以重复,以便另举一两例对难点作进一步解释。

六、词条词大部分是句子中的误用词,即在例句中用错了的单词和词组。例如: When do you hope the car to be ready? 这是一个误句,其中误用词是 hope, 所以列在 hope 条下。在这个词条中,说明作为动词的 hope, 不能用在这样的句子结构中表达这样的意思,而应该用 expect。但也有不少的词条词不是误用词,而是关键词。例如: He looks older than his age. 这个误句中的误用词是 his age, 但这个错误出现的主要原因,在于未能掌握 than 的用法,可见关键词不是 his age 而是 than, 所以这个例子就列在 than 条下而不是 age 条下。再如: Anne did not have time to talk with me when I last saw her as she was hurrying up to go to her office. 这个误句中的误用词是 to go, 但错误的关键在于没有掌握 hurry 的用法,所以这个误句列在 hurry 条下,而不是 go 条下。只有这样,这本书才能起到“词典”的作用: 读者对哪个单词的用法没有把握,便可查阅哪个词条。

七、本词典中约有四分之一的词条词之后划一破折号,然后

又出现一个或数个单词。这有以下五种情形：

1. 同义词和近义词的比较。如：在 healthful—healthy 这个词条下，讲 healthful 和 healthy 之间的区别；loudly—aloud 这个词条，讲的是 loudly 和 aloud 的区别；look¹⁰ for—fetch 词条讲的是 look for 和 fetch 的区别；同样 look¹² over—overlook；like¹²—alike；like¹³—as；like¹⁵—such as 等等，都是同义词和近义词的比较和辨析的词条。

2. 同一动词后接介词与不接介词的比较。如：suffer—suffer from 条下讲的是 suffer 在何种情形下不须后接 from，在何种情形下必须后接 from；同样：consult—consult with；ask—ask about；wash—wash up 等等，都讨论这个问题。

3. 同一动词后接不同介词或副词产生不同意义的比较。如：compete—with, in 这一条讲的是 compete with 和 compete in 的意义和用法的区别；同样：compare—with, to；get—with, through；take—as, for 等等。形容词也如此：在 anxious—about, for 词条下，讲解了 anxious about 和 anxious for 的意义和用法区别。

4. 同一名词用于不同介词之后的比较。如：holiday—on, for 这一词条讲的是 on holiday 和 for holiday 之间的区别；corner—in, at 词条下讲 in the corner 和 at the corner 的不同；同样 street—in, on, along 中讲 in the street, on the street 和 along the street 的意义和用法的区别。

5. 词形相似的一些单词的比较。如：humane—human；urbane—urban；handwork—handiwork；licence—license；custom—costume 等等。从这个意义上说，这本词典又在很大程度上兼备了同义词意义和用法辨析的功能。
