前 言

中国改革开放二十年来,对外经济贸易事业取得了惊人的成就。这其中作为国际通用语言的英语功不可没。在新的千年即将到来之际,经贸战线又传佳音:经过长达十三年的艰苦谈判,中国终于有望在不久的将来重返世贸组织这个大家庭。因此,外语这一交际工具无疑将变得更加重要。在教学过程中,我们接触到一些来自进出口公司、金融机构、外企等单位从事外经贸工作的人士,他们普遍反映,以往外经贸英语方面的书大多属教科书,练习占的篇幅较长,迫切需要一本内容全面、简明、实用、类似外经贸英语手册的书,而且携带、阅读起来方便。本书正好满足了这一愿望。

本书以对外经贸活动的整个过程为线索,从抵达、打电话、宴请、购物、过海关等简单的日常活动到外经贸活动的具体环节,如: 询盘、报盘、还盘、佣金、折扣、订货、装运、付款、合同、代理、索赔等,又衍生到广告、销售以及不同的贸易种类,如:补偿贸易、加工与装配贸易。本书包括三十个单元,每单元由对话和精选常用句(中、英文对照)组成,共有近60个对话和近2000个常用句。本书在编写过程中取材广泛,我们参考了四十多种中外有关方面的书籍,使其适用于从事或即将从事国际贸易、进出口业务的人士、中高等院校师生及英语自学者等。因此,本书定会受到广大英语爱好者及商务人员的喜爱。
