内 容 提 要

本书根据《大学英语教学大纲》中对词汇及语法结构的要求编写,在英语动词、同(近)义词和语法结构方面都有很强的实践性与针对性。本书由找人深,四、六级结合,可与目前使用的多种英语教材配套使用。全书包括五个部分:前三部分为常用动词、四级和六级动词;第四部分为同(近)义词——同(近)义动词不包括在内,这一部分附有简要注释;第五部分为语法结构(精选出具有代表性的100题,基本概括了一些重大测试中经常涉及到的语法问题)。全书所用词汇可覆盖《大纲》要求的单词总量的90%以上,书后备有全部答案。本书的主要对象是大学生、研究生、出国人员和科技人员,并可供广大英语学习者自修使用。

根据《大学英语教学大纲》的要求,针对国家教委目前组织的 CET 四级、六级测试,我们编写了这套大学英语学习丛书。
