

前言

- 3、5分钟后再次测试。你可以用遮住已填的单词或请别人提问的方式重复练习,直到记住所有单词。
- 4、擦去答案。
- 5、隔一天再做一遍(你应该能记住大部分单词 了)。
- 6、最后,在接下来的一个月内再做两遍,这样 所有单词就印在你的脑海中了。




