译者的话

在此千年交接之际,人类对未来充满了 美好的憧憬,攻克癌症当列为首要任务之一。 癌症已成为当代人类最主要的"杀手"。除身 体病痛之外,癌症对患者造成的巨大心理和 精神创伤是其他慢性疾病所不能比拟的。此 外,癌症的医疗费用和资源消耗亦已成为社 会沉重的负担。因此,攻克癌症不仅是医学 界的重大课题,而且也为各国政府所关注,为 此投入了大量人财物力。随着近年来科学技 术的飞速发展,对癌症发病机制的认识已深 入至分子水平,从而为创建新的治疗方法并 最终战胜癌症奠定了理论基础。人类在与癌 症长期的斗争中已积累了丰富的经验,各类 文献著述层出不穷,令人目不暇接。人们迫 切希望有一部权威而系统的专著,以能反映 癌症最新的研究成果,并能作为医疗实践的 指南。DeVita 主编的《Cancer》应列为堪当此 任者之首选。这也是我们决定接受山东科学 技术出版社的委托翻译该书的宗旨和目的。

《Cancer》一书 1982 年首版发行以来,一直被认为是肿瘤学界最权威的专著。从癌症的基本理论到治疗学实践,本书均有详尽的论述。此次翻译的是最新的 1997 年第五版。与前几版不同,第五版内容有很大的调整,增添了"现代肿瘤学基础"部分,分述有关肿瘤

分子生物学、信号传导和免疫学基础知识。 第二部分"肿瘤学原理"纳入了细胞周期、细 胞遗传学、肿瘤转移及其病因学的最新资料, 且将癌症预防置于更突出的地位。第三部分 "肿瘤学实践"的内容亦有较大更新,肿瘤各 论诸章节之前,均有关于分子生物学的简介, 并新辟章节讨论肿瘤保健及相关社会学问 题。书中有些内容与我国国情可能不尽相 符,但仍可作为借鉴和参考。第四部分"肿瘤 治疗的新举措",列举了近年来初露端倪的肿 瘤诊疗新方法和新措施,并展望了未来的发 展趋势。总而言之,就内容之广博和论述之 深邃,本书均可称为肿瘤学的现代百科全书。 译者期望该书中译本的问世,能使更多的医 务工作者特别是肿瘤工作者,分享其所载先 进科技成果,为推动我国肿瘤学事业的发展 尽绵薄之力。

山东医科大学附属医院是本书翻译的主体单位。绝大部分译者为具有硕士以上学历的中青年业务骨干,具有较高的英语水平和较丰富的临床实践经验。但是,面对内容如此浩瀚和深奥的巨著,许多崭新内容又缺乏中文参考资料,仍深感翻译是再创作的艰辛,其翻译难度非亲历者所能体会。著者 200 余人,文体风格各异;译者 160 余人,水平参差
