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### 大学英语四级考试词汇与结构习题集萃 2500 详解

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本书主要包括以下内容: 1. 关于大学英语四级考试, 重点介绍 1999 年教育部主持制定的 《大学英语教学大纲》(修订本)对大学英语四级教学的要求和四级考试的内容结构; 2. 词汇与语法结构练习题; 3. 练习答案详解; 4. 四级测试常考语法结构。

本书词汇练习题是依据《大学英语教学大纲》(修订本)所附通用词汇表(1—4级)所列词汇,从国内外各类试题中精选出的。这些练习题最常用,搭配力最强,考试频度最大。词汇练习题 2000 道,语法结构练习题 500 道,包括了考试频度最大的重要语法项目及固定结构,如时态、语态、情态动词、不定式、分词和分词独立结构、动名词、名词从句、强调句、让步状语从句、比较状语从句、复合宾语、倒装句、省略句、倍数表达法、附加疑问句、连词、名词及名词所有格等,注意将各种语法现象不同的试题尽可能齐全地编入。本书在词汇练习和语法练习后面有对选题答案的详细讲解,对各种重要句型一一列出,并对重要例句说明其用法。实际上本书的重点在注释,它提供了丰富的信息。在本书,附了一项"四级测试常考语法结构"、针对性非常强。

为帮助读者精确掌握本书所收词汇和语法项目的内容,每个练习后面均附有习题答案详解。为弥补收词有限之不足,注释特别注意了对每个词条多种搭配的讲解,对同义词和反义词作了对比列举,尤其对易混词和近义词作了详细讲解。为帮助读者扩充词汇量,注释中对词条的级别明确标出,以便读者有目的地加强记忆。当各类重要语法项目在练习中第一次出现时,注释一般先对该语法项目作总的概括性讲解,以后遇到同类语法题时则作简短讲解,以起巩固和加深印象之作用。

需要说明的是,《大学英语教学大纲》(修订本)对大学英语四级教学提出了更高的要求,要求本科生在大学四年期间英语学习不同断,四年修业届满时必须通过四级考试,这是对本科生英语学习的最低要求。《大学英语教学大纲》(修订本)中列出了 4200 个四级词汇,这是最基本的常用词汇,是四、六级考试和考研取得成功的基础。六级试题的 30 个词汇试题中,四级词汇约占八个,考研试题的词汇部分四级词汇约占三分之一。

本书的阅读对象是大学英语四六级考生、硕士研究生考生、托福考生和广大英语自学者。本书也是大学、中学英语教师的得力参考书。

相信本书将有助于广大读者熟练掌握英语基础知识和有效地提高英语应试能力。

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### 一、关于大学英语四级考试

1999 年 9 月正式公布的《大学英语教学大纲》(修订本)规定了对高等学校非英语专业的本科生进行英语教学的基本要求和教学目的。

《大学英语教学大纲》(修订本)(以下简称《大纲》(修订本))规定:"大学英语教学的目的是:培养学生具有较强的阅读能力和一定的听、说、写、译能力……"这比原大纲提出了更高的要求,原大纲要求"初步的写和说的能力",对译没有提出要求,而新大纲对写、说、译都提出了较高的要求,将它们提到与听同等重要的位置。

《大纲》(修订本)规定大学英语教学四年不间断,分为 1—2 年级基础阶段和 3—4 年级应用提高阶段。新大纲规定新生入校时应已掌握 1800 个英语单词,在一、二年级结束时应已领会式掌握 4200 个单词(包括复用式掌握 2500 词)及常用词组,并具有按照基本构词法识别生词的能力。所谓领会式掌握是指对《大纲》(修订本)规定应掌握的词汇在一定的上下文中能知道其词义和识别其词类。所谓复用式掌握是指不但能识其类和知其义,而且会运用。

《大纲》(修订本)对阅读能力规定:"能顺利阅读语言难度中等的一般性题材的文章,掌握中心大意以及说明中心大意的事实和细节,并能进行一定的分析、推理和判断,领会作者的观点和态度,阅读速度达到每分钟 70 词。"《大纲》(修订本)对听的能力规定:"能听懂英语讲课,并能听懂题材……基本上没有生词、语速为每分钟 130—150 词的简短会话、谈话、报道和讲座,掌握中心大意,抓住要点和有关细节,领会讲话者的观点和态度。"《大纲》(修订本)对写的能力规定:"能在阅读难度与课文相仿的书面材料时做笔记、回答问题、写提纲,能就一定的话题或提纲在半小时内写出 120—150 词的短文,能写短信和便条,表达意思清楚,无重大语言错误。"《大纲》(修订本)对译的能力规定:"能借助词典将难度略低于课文的英语短文译成汉语,理解正确,译文达意,译速为每小时 300 英语单词。能借助词典将内容熟悉的汉语文学材料译成英语,译文达意,无重大语言错误,译速每小时 250 汉字。"

《大学英语四级考试》试题共分五个部分: 1. 听力: 20 分钟, 20 小题, 占 20 分 (第一部分为 10 个简短对话, 10 小题, 10 分; 第二部分为三篇短文, 10 小题, 10 分; 或者第一部分为对话, 10 小题, 10 分; 第二部分为听写, 前 7 个空听写单词, 后 3 个空听写句子, 共 10 分)。 2. 阅读理解: 35 分钟, 有四篇短文, 共 20 小题, 40 分。 3. 词汇与结构: 20 分钟, 30 小题, 15 分。 4. 完形填空: 15 分钟, 20 小题, 10 分 (或者英译汉, 从阅读理解的四篇文章中抽出 5 个句子, 译成汉语, 10 分)。 5. 作文: 30 分钟, 写出一篇 120—150 词的短文, 满分 15 分。
