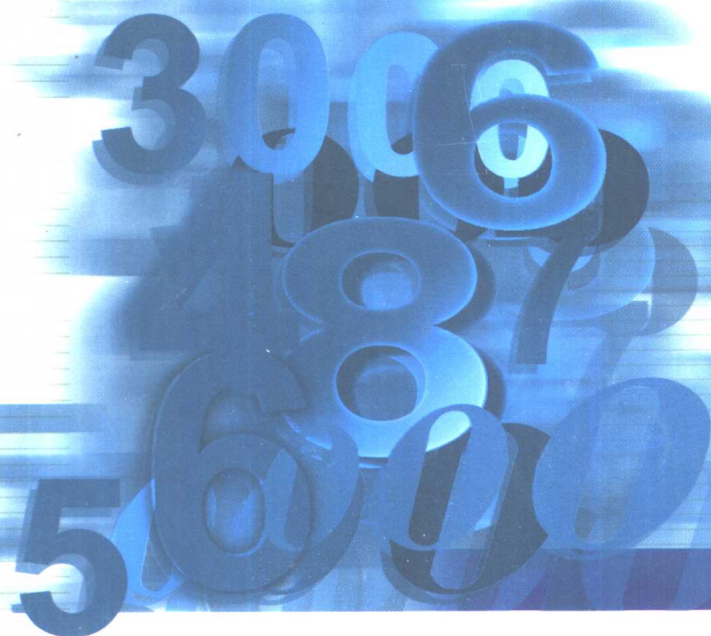

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内 容 提 要

《英语 5000~6000 核心词汇密集训练》是一部专门进行英语词汇训练及自测的习题集。经过对国内外数十种英语标准化考试中所涉及的词汇进行分析和筛选之后,我们选编了 46 套词汇练习题。每套练习由 100 题组成,题后配有疑难词及词组注释。这些内容均是进行中级阅读及中级考试所必备的核心词汇,其覆盖面广,重复率高,语句规范,题型真实,词量充实,针对性强,符合读者的特点和需要。书后附有答案,读者可集中时间和精力进行自练自测,以获得最佳效果。

本书适用于参加大学英语 4~5 级考试、全国硕士研究生入学考试、全国公共英语等级考试 4 级、各类职称考试等人员,同时对广大读者扩大巩固词汇量及参加各类相应的考试也颇有裨益。

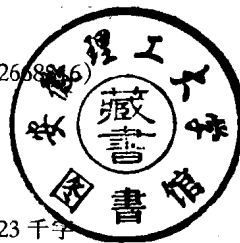

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前言

“大学英语词汇学习系列”是以巩固与扩大英语学习者初、中、高级词汇量为主的练习题集。众所周知,词汇是语言的核心部分之一。对掌握英语各个环节的重要性,语言学家和语言教师可能会有所争论,但对词汇的重要性的认识则是一致的。没有足够量的词汇,您的听、说、读、写等各方面的能力都会受到很大的限制。特别是在实际应用英语和参加各种英语标准化考试时,更是捉襟见肘。

根据语言词汇原理和国内外语言学界对词汇的理论研究,我们对国内外流行的各种标准化考试所涉及的词汇进行了分析研究,并对词汇的覆盖面和重复率进行了测定,再经认真地收集、整理、分类,最终形成了目前三册书(初级、中级、高级)的规模,以满足目前社会上参加不同等级英语标准化考试者的需要。

“大学英语词汇学习系列”能够极大地提高广大英语学习者及各类考生在英语阅读和应试中辨认词汇的能力。因为经反复的调查研究表明,辨认词汇的能力对学习英语的人来说,要比使用词汇的能力更为实际,更为重要。

积累与扩大英语词汇量不外有两种途径:直接学习词汇和间接学习词汇。直接学习词汇指的是孤立地学习词汇,例如背生词表、作词汇练习、研究前后缀、词根构成法等。间接学习词汇指的是通过阅读,在接收信息的同时不自觉地学习词汇。这两种途径是相辅相成的,“大学英语词汇学习系列”则更加侧重于后者。

在此,我们无意夸大某一种学习词汇的方法。科学地讲,直接学习英语词汇的能力是因人而异的。尤其是在初级阶段和中级阶段,人们记忆英词单词的能力是惊人的。国外的语言学实验表明:一个人集中时间学习记忆单词的百分比要比分散学习记忆单词的百分比高。这就表明,记得快、记得牢的人并不一定忘得快。由此,我们获得启迪:在一个人精力充沛的时间内进行“密集型”的单词学习会获得极佳的效果。这就是我们编写此套丛书的理论根据。

许多语言教师都赞成这种观点:新单词应通过出现在上下文中记忆而不应孤立地通过词汇表记忆。许多学生也认为:通过上下文记忆单词总是比通过词汇表记忆单词更容易理解掌握词意,而且记忆深刻牢固。因此,我们力图使学生通过阅读完整的句子来吸收完整的语言信息,多方面地理解词意,从而最大限度地使学生受益。

就所收录的内容而言,本系列涵盖了英语的十大词类(动词、名词、形容词、副词、介词、连词、代词、感叹词、数词和冠词)以及动词词组、介词词组、名词词组、副词词组和其它一些惯用词组。

根据所收入词汇量的多少和其难度大小,我们将本系列分为初级本、中级本和高级本。

初级本由 3000~4000 核心词汇组成,相当于大学英语 2~3 级考试和公共外语等级考试 3 级所应掌握的词汇量。

中级本由 5000~6000 核心词汇组成,相当于大学英语 4~5 级考试和公共外语等级考试 4 级所应掌握的词汇量。

高级本由 7000~8000 核心词汇组成,相当于大学英语 6 级考试、专业英语 4 级和公共英

语等级考试 5 级所应掌握的词汇量。

这种由 3000 核心词汇到 8000 核心词汇形成的一个有效阶梯,将成为任何一位迈向英语王国勇士的必经之路。

以上是我们编写本系列丛书的一些思考。词汇记忆如同其它技能一样,是可能学习并掌握的。如果“密集训练”能对各层次的英语学习者提供一些帮助的话,我们将感到无比的欣慰。
