■ 本考试的范围主要是教学大纲所规定的基础阶段一级至三级说与译的技能以外的全部内容。

包括五个部分:

- 听力理解部分的目的是测试学生获取口头信息的能力;
- 阅读理解部分的目的是测试学生通过阅读获取信息的能力,既要求准确,也要求一定的速度;
- 词语用法和语法结构部分的目的是测试学生运用词汇、短语及语法结构的能力;
- 完形填空部分的目的是测试学生综合运用语言的能力;
- 段落写作部分的目的是测试学生英语写作的初步能力。

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第一部分

听力理解

听力应试技巧

听力一直是我国考生的弱项，得分普遍较低，因此我们必须注重听力的培养和提高。在大学英语三级考试中，听力共分两个部分，第一部分是简短对话听力理解，这部分包括十组简短的对话，每组对话后有一个问题，要求考生根据对话内容从四个选项中选出一个最佳答案。第二部分是短文听力理解。这部分包括二到三篇短文，每篇短文后有二到四道题，要求考生根据短文内容从四个选项中选出最佳答案。下面简单谈谈听力的应试技巧。

1. 快速阅读选项进行预测。拿到试卷后，快速浏览选项，有的可以猜出录音的内容和所要提的问题。如：

- A. A teacher B. A farmer
C. A doctor D. A worker

从上面的选项中可以看出此题内容是关于人的职务。又如：

- A. On Sunday B. On Saturday
C. On Monday D. On Friday

从此题选项中可以猜出录音中要问关于时间的问题，在听的时候注意这一点，就可以很快找出正确答案了。

2. 抓住中心思想。在听段落的时候，要抓住关键地方和主要内容。不要刻意追求听懂每一个字，这样往往事与愿违，当你对某一个词冥思苦想时，录音已放在后面去了，只抓到一些单词，丢掉了整个内容，结果是得不偿失。因此听音时一定要在某个单词上停留，要跟着录音，抓住中心思想。

3. 边听边作记录或符号。在平时训练听力的时候就可以作记录。对于一些人、数字、时间、地方、比较等内容，可适当用一些自己能看懂的符号记录下来。

4. 保持清醒的头脑。在听力测试中，一定要保持镇定，若遇到

没听懂的地方，千万不要慌乱，也不要过多地想，果断地作出选择，然后接着听后面的录音，否则会影响后面的发挥。
