本套从台湾学习出版有限公司引进的大众中 级英语自测系列丛书,共分为七个单册,分别为: 《听力自测》(上)、《听力自测》(下)、《词汇自测 500 题》、《阅读自测》、《完形填空自测》、《语法自测》、 《写作·口语自测》,意在帮助具备中级英语水平的 学习者进行各项技能的综合训练,最终达到听、说、 读、写几方面得到全方位自我检测与提高的目的。

《听力自测》(上、下)共包括十六个测试单元, 每个单元分为试题与详解两部分。十六个单元相 对独立,测试形式相同,但每个单元内的试题部分 由浅入深,由易到难。学习者可在录音带的配合 下,按单元进行强化训练及自测,以提高英语听力 技能。
