致读者

本书将帮助你学习大量的英语词汇。但是要真正掌握生词，你必须反复练习。下面这种方法有助于你学习生词。

- 1、先仔细阅读题目，然后开始测试，用铅笔写出答案。
- 2、做完练习后检查答案并改正错误。再看一遍练习题，对你原来不认识的单词或刚才做错的习题多加留意。
- 3、5分钟后再次测试。你可以用遮住已填的单词或请别人提问的方式重复练习，直到记住所有单词。
- 4、擦去答案。
- 5、过一天再做一遍（你应该能记住大部分单词了）。
- 6、最后，在接下来的一个月内再做两遍，这样所有单词就印在你的脑海中了。

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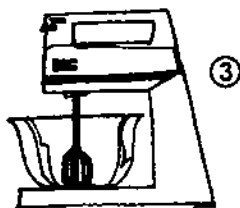
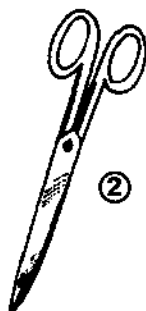
