
世界名篇 注释详尽 由易到难 故事寓言

前 言

学习英语必须经常阅读,反复运用。学生除了认真学习教科书外,还应当多阅读一些课外辅助读物,以有利于外语水平的提高。

编选本书的目的在于:通过一些深浅适当、内容有趣的故事来引起学生学习英语的兴趣,培养学生的阅读习惯,巩固学生已学过的词汇、短语和语法知识,并使学生适当地吸收一些新的词汇,扩大知识范围。

本书所选材料有广大读者所熟悉的脍炙人口的寓言故事、 黑人男孩《小汤姆》以及《天方夜谈》中的《阿里巴巴、女奴 和四十大盗》、《鲁滨孙漂流记》中的精彩片段。

这些材料形式多样,编排上根据由易到难、由浅人深的原则。本书第一、二部分附有词汇表,对一些专用名词、惯用词组、较难的句子等都作了详细的汉语注释。初中三年级以上学生完全可以凭借注解顺畅地阅读。难度较大的第三部分为英汉对照,适于初三以上直至大学生的阅读。
