英文锁定(icansay.com)在当时 已经是一个注册用户超过十万的大 型英文学习娱乐网站,每个月的电子 英文杂志要发送三百万份。电子杂 志受欢迎的程度常常出乎我们的意 料,由于发送量大,我们杂志技术合 作方的服务器常常超载。拥有庞大 的在线用户资源,不代表一切,怎样 把这些用户资源和企业长期的盈利 挂起钩来才是真正需要考虑的问题。 最终的结果是 icansay 要走一条跨媒 体的道路,把在线的品牌带入线下。 而在中国,有这个能力的英语教育机 构还太少。这几个月,互联网业风雨 萧条,一家很著名的电子图文公司进 行了大裁员,更加让我们坚定了做跨

媒体英语教育平台的信心。

icansay. com 最早追溯于 1999 年 4 月,"全真英语"以其全真、精彩、体贴、专业的形象和服务迅速取得了成功。中国著名的英文《21 世纪报》这样说英文锁定:

On www. ICANSAY. com, learners can test their English vocabulary online. Meanwhile, they can even compete with each others in the verbal game, which brings much fun to those who find memorizing English words tedious.

"A good game and a school exam are essentially the same thing: There are a bunch of tasks and you get points for fulfilling them. Learners, however, hate exams and love games," said Dr Jan Stelovsky, a professor in the field of computer science at the University of Hawaii.

1. AC/DC, Fun for the Whole Family AC/DC 乐队的摇滚 ②

AC/DC have perfected the two - hour guitar solo, interrupted now and then by some incomprehensible vocals, fiery pyrotechnics, and other sideshow divertissements -all grandly entertaining. If this is what mainstream rock 'n' roll has become, so be it.

Along the way, AC/DC have evolved rock 'n' roll into wholesome family entertainment. At the band's sold-out concert Friday, March 23 at Nashville's Gaylord Entertainment Center, the crowd epitomized rock 'n' roll family values. Mom and Dad-sporting their heirloom black AC/DC T-shirts-came hand in hand with their children and proudly bought them their first, white AC/DC tees. While the preshow PA system pumped out the Rolling Stones' "Sympathy for the Devil," the kids were happily putting on their spanking new shirts, fitting their just-bought AC/DC flashing-red-light devil horns onto their heads, and awaiting the oncoming circus.

And Angus and company didn't disappoint. From the first notes of "You Shook Me All Night Long," this was a very happy crowd, standing on its feet throughout the two-hour show. In addition to the marathon of metal from Angus Young and his attendant spastic antics, and singer Brian Johnson's jovial stage moves and guttural vocals, kids of all ages got:

- fantastic fireballs shooting out of the stage scaffolding during "Highway to Hell";
- the customary bronze Angus statue blowing clouds of smoke from its mouth and lighting up its red horns and yellow eyes and emitting sparklers;
- a huge inflated hooker hovering and dancing above the stage during "Whole Lotta Rosie";
- Johnson dangling from the giant AC/DC bell's clapper, high above the crowd, during "Hell's Bells";
- stage lighting so varied and powerful that at times the stage looked (and sounded) like an out-of-control 747 coming in low for a violent crash-landing;
- the booming salutes from six cannons onstage during the encore of "For Those About to Rock, We Salute You";

- 7. multi-screen videos depicting copulating animals during "Shoot to Thrill":
- 8. Young's usual striptease act, culminating in his dropping trou to reveal American flag underwear;
- a paper shower from confetti cannons at the end. The kids loved it all.

Seeing an 8-year-old boy singing all the words to "Highway to Hell" while his dad swigged from a giant, \$7 cup of beer and furiously played air guitar and his mom smiled contentedly at old rock 'n' roll memories—ah, that's the power of music to unite generations. The occasional cloud of marijuana smoke wafting through the crowd only underscored the fact that this band's music has spanned generations.

Young and Johnson very effectively used the runway that jutted out onto the floor from the stage to get close to the audience—very fan-oriented band, this. Both frequently darted down the runway and Johnson grabbed his crotch to teen squeals and then shook hands with fans, reaching out to tousle a small boy's hair now and then. Teen girls in little AC/DC halter tops held up a "We Want BIG BALLS" sign, asking for an AC/DC song they didn't get. Everyone had a very nice evening, and left the arena whooping and hollering. If, as is the case with AC/DC, a rock band can no longer break new ground, it can at least be proud that it has paved its own road seamlessly.

2. Wanted: Suckers and Chumps 骗的就是你 ②

Do not pass go! Do not collect \$ 200. This is not a picture of the Monopoly game guy. It is the legendary W.C. Fields. But like Monopoly, the famous funnyman might be able to teach you something about business.



"You can't cheat an honest man. He has to have larceny in his heart in the first place."

这是 W. C. Fields 的处世之道,他在荧屏上是个可恶的醉鬼,玩弄女人,糜烂成性。他在现实生活中对钱却很有一套,1946 年他留下了百万家产,在那时候可真是一笔不小的数目。他的秘诀是什么呢?

He loved children, if they were properly cooked. He never drank anything stronger than gin ... before breakfast.

And he had his morals: "Anything worth having is worth cheating for," not to mention, "Never smarten up a chump." So why not consider taking career advice from W.C. Fields? OK, he was a child-hating, womanizing drunkard on screen, who scoured the Bible "for loopholes" and reckoned that everything he enjoyed was either "illegal, immoral or fattening." But at least he had a point of view.

W.C. may not have been P.C., but the funnyman was serious about money. By 1938, he was the highest paid star at Universal Studios, and in 1946, he left behind a \$1 million estate, a fortune in those days.

Why bother taking career advice from perpetually peppy motivators like Tony Robbins who want you to release the giant within when it's so much more liberating to cultivate your inner crab? W.C. says, "Start every day with a smile and get it over with." How's that for a strategy at your morning meeting?

Equal Opportunity Hatred

Field's legendary pratfalls from such classics as My Little Chickadee and The Bank Dick illustrate the self-help book's dos and don't, and his head-on wit is offered as a liberating antidote to a workplace stifled by forced smiles and stilted conversations.

"I am free of all prejudices," Fields always said. "I hate everyone equally."

But it's Fields' stellar rise and staying power that prove inspirational. As a kid in vaudeville, he juggled his way onto
