# 前言

本册为《说家常》Domestic Life 分册,内含 15 个单元,主要涉及家居及家用设施、饮食、衣物、旅行和交通;说电脑、社交、球类活动和其他运动;介绍与问候礼仪、打电话、看病和抓药;银行业务;发型和化妆;看电视、邮局服务、日常生活中的紧急情况等方面的英语常用语的学习和训练。

## Housing

In Britain, for the new couple the first essential after marriage is a place to live in, because they usually want to live independently. Housing in Britain is better than in most countries in the world.
