#### 前言

谚语,是口语中常用的现成话。狭义的谚语是生活实践中总结出来的带有实践经验的话,如常识谚、事理谚、气象谚等。广义上的谚语则大体上相当于俗语,包括歇后语和惯用语等。在表达思想感情时恰当地使用谚语,可以增加语言的鲜明性、生动性和感染力。

每个民族都有自己的谚语。生活习俗不同,文化背景不同,谚语也不同。即使同一思想内容的谚语,不同民族也可有不同的说法。

根据笔者多年的经验,我国的英语学习者学习英语的时间不可谓不长,掌握的词汇量不可谓不多,但要说出或者写出文采飞扬、妙趣横生的地道英语却不是很容易。解决的办法诚然很多,而熟练掌握一些地道的英语谚语不失为一条捷径。本词典则在一定程度上满足了这种需要。

本词典在编写上本着以下的原则:

- ①不仅收录常见的汉语谚语,而且收录大量的英语谚语。这里有两种情况,一是英谚本身有对应的汉谚,二是虽没有成熟的汉谚,但其汉译有较强的哲理性,且可为国人接受,也一并收录。
- ②翻译上取直译为主,意译为辅,尽可能保持原汁原味,又最大限度地做到简洁、流畅、琅琅上口、易学易记。
- ③以汉语拼音字母为序排列,版式简洁明快,便于读者翻检查考,真正做到开卷有益。

限于编者水平,本词典必定存在一些错误与疏漏,诚望读者批评指正。
