

"阅读理解"是一种语言综合运用能力,是从书面 语言材料中获得信息,吸收知识,积累词汇,孰记句型、 培养能力的一种技能,这种技能含有对语言的识别,记 忆、理解等几方面,而它们又是互相关联,前后呼应, 彼此促进的。任何一篇文章总要向读者说明何人何时、 何地因何故而发生了何事,这就是"新闻五要素", who (谁), what (什么时候) where (什么地点), why,(为什么),通常称之为"五个W"。一 船说来, 每篇文章大都离不开五个 W, 命题人员首先要在阅读 材料中用种种方式来交代五个 W、然后在思考题部分 D四个选项,除正确的一项外,其余三项都提供了不符 合原文某个 W 内容。学生能否在四个互相接近,而又 似是而非的答案中,根据原文所暗示的各个 W 的情况 选出唯一正确的答案,反映他们对文中各个W的认识, 因此,学生做阅读理解试题时,一定要牢记这五个W, 边读边分析边记忆。

Adams was strongly against slavery and attempted to outlaw it in Washington D.C., People began to look back on his presidency with a different view. Now they saw that he was an independent man with high ideal who loved his country and hated slavery. Adams died in 1848 when speaking in the House of Representative.


In sports the sexes are separated(分开的). Women and men do not run or swim in the same game. Women are less strong than men. That at least is what people say. Women are called "the weaker sex", or if men want to please them, "the fair sex". But boys and girls are taught together at schools and universities. There are women who are famous Prime Ministers, scientists and writers. And women live longer than men. A European woman can expect to live until the age of 74; a man only until he is 68. Are women's bodies really weaker?

The fastest men ran a mile in under 4 minutes. The best women need 5 minutes. Women's times are always slower than men's, but some facts are a surprise. Some of the fastest women swimmers today are girls. One of them swam 400 metres in 4 minutes 21.2 seconds when she was only 16. The first "Taizan" (人猿泰山) in films was an Olympic swimmer, Johnny Weissmuller. His fastest 400 metres was 4 minutes 59.1 seconds which is 37.9 seconds slower than a girl 50 years later! This does not mean that women are catching men up. Conditions are very different now, and sport is much more serious. It is so serious that some women are given hormone injections (注射荷尔紫). At the Olympics a doctor has to check whether the women are really women or not. It seems sad that sport has such problems. Life can be very complicated (复杂) when there are two separate sexes.

When American won its independence from England, it had thirteen states. Each of the states was represented on the American flag by a star. All these states were in the eastern part of the continent.
