培养学生具有较强的阅读能力,一定的听的能力,初步的写和说的能力,使学生能以英语为工具,获取所需要的信息,并为进一步提高英语水平打下较实、较好的基础,这是文理工科院校英语教学的目的。而学生在英语学习中,突出的困难就是词汇的记忆、理解和意义上讲,词汇记得越多,阅读能力、听的能力、写和说的能力也就会相应地迅速提高。为了配合英语教学,使学生有一部实用,有效的工具书,我们编写了《现代英语词汇活用辞典》。

在英语学习中,词汇的记忆方法固然很多,但其中 最好的方法应是理解记忆法。为了达到这一目的,本 《辞典》对词汇、释义和例句三部分内容进行了精心设 计,以有助于读者的理解记忆。第一部分只列出英语首 词和音标,为默读快速记忆部分。读者在查阅这一部分 时,若系熟知的单词,则一扫而过,但脑海里同时浮现 出该单词的汉语释义。这样就无意中复习并加深了对 该词汇的记忆。第二部分只列出首词的汉语释义,为灵 活记忆部分。只有在查阅第一部分时,自己不认识或未 记军的单词才去查阅第二部分的汉语释义。有些首词 的义项较多,不必都记,可有选择地灵活记忆,先记急 需的和用得较多的义项。第三部分则列出首词各个义 项的例句,为理解性记忆部分,通过第二部分知道了词 汇的汉语释义,为了能进一步掌握单词的用法、词与词 的搭配关系以及与其它词构成成语的用法等,便可查 阅这一部分。

本《辞典》以高等学校文理工科本科《英语教学大

纲》所规定的通用词汇 5,350 词为基础,另外增加了科普、科技、高新技术、经济管理、外贸、旅游等方面的词汇,总计收词条近 10,000 个。它是大中学生及英语爱好者学习、工作、查阅资料及参考必备之工具书。 在此应特别提到的是,在本辞典的编辑出版过程中,承蒙山西高校联合出版社总编刘长鼎教授大力支持,本书的责任编辑班健民同志和崔爱红老师,精心修改、校对书稿,使本辞典能得以顺利出版,在此表示谢忱。

限于水平和经验,书中一定存在不少缺点和错误, 希望各位老师、同学们及广大英语爱好者在使用过程 中多提意见,多给予批评指正,以便修订时改正。
