## 前 言

在国家教委为大学本科生制定了《大学英语教学大纲》之后,许多省市也相继为本地区普通高等专科学校制定了“大学英语教学基本要求或教学大纲”,对高等专科层次的大学英语教学工作起到了积极的推动作用。每年一次的高等专科学校英语测试(即二级考试),也使大学英语的教学和学习出现了崭新的局面。

大学英语二级考试的题型不同于三、四、六级。二级试题的听力部分为10组简短对话题,分数占全部试题的10%;语速为每分钟90个单词,每题读两遍,每题间约停20秒。

根据编者的教学经验和许多学生的体会,听力部分考的好坏是至关重要的。这一部分成绩的得失往往是高分与低分的“分水岭”。尽管听力这一项仅占总分的小部分,但由于它是首先出现的部分,对考生在整场考试中的心理状态影响极大,考的顺利,会增强信心,成绩自然提高;反之,会由于心理状态紧张而造成连续失误。

因此,如何准备应试,如何顺利通过考试,必然成为老师和学生所关心的问题。要想高分通过二级考试,虽说不能靠考前突击,而是靠平时努力。但是,如果考前能得到一些适当的解题指导和训练,编者认为一定会得到事半功倍的效果。

鉴于此情况,编者根据几年来的课堂教学和二级听力强化训练的经验,参考了大量资料,编写了此书,供二级考前听力训练时用。

本书共有 44 套听力测试题,配有听力原文、答案和录音磁带。学生可以通过自测提高听的能力,增加考前强化训练的机会,是一本极为实用的听力自学材料。

本书除了给全日制二级考生提供考前训练机会,也适用于电大、夜大、自学考试等听力训练材料。愿此书伴你顺利通过二级第一关。
