1. Is Miss Mary in? 玛丽小姐在吗?

用于打电话的时候,其类似的说法还有:

May I speak to Miss Mary?

我能和玛丽小姐说话吗?

I'd like to speak to Miss Mary.

我想找一下玛丽小姐?

其答语一般分为三种情况:

①当接电话的人是玛丽时: It's me. (是我) Speaking.
(请讲) Please speaking. (请讲)

②当接电话的人不是玛丽但玛丽在时:

A moment, please. (请稍等) Hold on. (别挂断)

③当接电话的人不是玛丽且玛丽又不在时:

I am sorry, she is out now.

恐怕她现在不在。

I am afraid she is not in.

她现在不在。

另外还可以说:

Can I take a message.

我可以给她捎个口信吗?

Would you like to leave a message?

你可以留个口信吗?
