前 言

目前有一定英语基础的读者很需要一本会话手册,本书正是为了满足这一需要而编写的。书中提供了一些日常生活用语和社交用语,语言比较浅易,内容力求实用,便于读者练习掌握,以提高会话能力。本书也可作口语教材,供课堂教学使用。

全书共五十题,由两部分组成。第一部分以日常生活为主要内容,共三十题,第二部分侧重某些感情的表达方式和一些社交场合常用套语,语言比第一部分稍难,共二十题。每题包括对话三一六段、语言难点注释、语言特点说明,以及若干词汇和常用语。书中部分对话曾在《英语学习》上发表过,这次汇编时又作了某些删改或增补。

书中对话所设想的场合多以国内为主,但大部分也适用于英语国家。对话中所用的语言既要避免"中国式的英语",也要避免使用一些粗鲁、鄙俗或过于俏皮的话,力求平易、地道。

本书在编写过程中, 曾得到北京外国语学院一些老师的 大力帮助。英国专家 David Crook 曾审阅全部对话, 刘世 沐教授和高厚堃、刘润清同志多方给予协助, 谨此志谢。

由于作者水平有限,本书一定有不少缺点错误,希望读者批评指正。
