

## 内容简介

本书根据《大学英语教学大纲》的要求,查阅了大量的字典、教材及专著,精选了极易混淆的约 800 条常用短语,分成 300 组。从实用角度出发,进行辨异,释义简明,例句精炼、典型、规范,并配有一定的练习,以供读者复习巩固之用。本书特别适合准备四六级统考、研究生入学考试及自学的读者,同时,也可以作为英语教师重要的参考书。

该丛书是为参加全国大学英语四六级统考的大学生而编写的。大学生经过高校一段时间的学习，已经基本掌握了大学英语方面的基本知识和要点，通过全国大学英语四六级统考应该说已经不成问题了。但是，这毕竟是一个未知数。而且对于相当一部分大学生来说，四六级统考能否顺利过关并不是很有把握。因为他们还没有实践经验，对于哪些知识点是一定要考的，哪些地方是一定不能丢分的，哪些地方又是最容易丢分的，类似这一系列问题，难免感到心里没底，把握不大。而对那些英语基础不太好，发挥好了可以勉强过关，发挥不好就过不了关的大学生来说，四六级统考更是一道横在他们面前的难关。

英语学习程度较好的同学，通过了四级还想过六级，通过了六级还想考研、出国，他们已不满足于能过四六级，而是还要瞄准更高的目标。因而他们不仅希望在四六级统考时能过关，而且还要多拿分、拿高分。基础稍差一点的同学，则首先是希望在四六级统考中不丢分、少丢分，该得的分一定要得到，易混易错的地方也尽量少丢分或不丢分。这就需要在平时学习掌握的基础上，利用统考前的短暂时间，更进一步，更上一层楼。

为此，我们特策划组织了该套丛书。丛书名之曰“考前快通车”，就是希望通过临考前短暂的复习和训练，使同学们牢固地掌握住那些必考的知识点，在这些地方做到绝对不丢分；而对于那些易混易错最容易丢分的地方，同学们只要心中有了数，就可以做到

尽量少丢分,甚至不丢分。做到了这些,基础稍差一点的同学就可以顺利过关,基础较好的同学就可以多拿分、拿高分。

参加丛书编写的作者大都是长期从事大学英语教学和研究的专家、教授。他们有多年教学和科研的经验,又长期跟踪大学英语四六级统考的发展变化,对大学英语教学和全国四六级统考的一般规律都有较深刻的把握。相信他们的著作一定能够对大学生学习英语并通过四六级考试,提供较大的帮助。

该丛书首批推出五种,今后将逐步补充、完善、修改、提高。值此丛书出版之际,我们衷心地希望从事大学英语教学和研究的诸位专家及广大读者,对该丛书的编写和出版提出宝贵的意见和建议,诚挚的批评更是我们所衷心欢迎和十分需要的。因为我们有一个共同的目的,就是希望能够把书编得更好,更有针对性,更能对大学生的英语学习和备考有所帮助。

英语短语浩如烟海,令人眼花缭乱,记不胜记。在记忆短语的过程中,最感棘手的问题之一就是一些乍看起来意思相同或相近和一些在结构形式上相似的短语,有时一不小心就会用错,造成误解,闹出笑话。例如:gaze at, look at, glance at, glare at, stare at 都有“看”、“注意看”的意思,但在用法上有相当大的差别,使用的场合也有所不同。又如:at a time, at one time, at times 在结构上很相似,但它们在用法上和意思上都有很大的差异。同义短语常常很容易用错,这是因为一个短语的由来和应用是有一定背景和寓意的,不管表面上使用什么字眼,真正的含义往往由使用场合及情节来表达,因而同义短语不一定能够相互替换。此外,当一个单词分别与其它词类搭配而形成不同的短语时,或短语中的词前后顺序颠倒时,释义与原词不同,而短语之间则可能同义,也可能彼此互不相干。这就说明了辨义的重要性。

为了帮助广大读者更快、更好地学会和运用这些短语,我们精选了 700 余条短语,分成 300 项,编成了《四六级易混易错短语解析》一书。本书具有以下特点:

1. 科学性。编者在成书之前进行了大量的调查研究,查阅了大量的资料,分析了多种有关同义短语的教材、词典及专著,对所选短语进行了严格的筛选。例句选自国内外出版的权威英语词典、手册、教材和读物。对于短语的释义、例解、比较、辨析、汉译等,尽力做到科学有据,语言地道。

2. 针对性。本书针对当前大学生的实际水平，并以解决他们实际存在的问题为出发点来挑选短语，对所选短语进行对比、辨析。例句精练典型，深浅恰当，使学生易于接受。

3. 实用性。本书的编著者都是多年从事大学英语四、六级教学，并辅导过多届全国大学英语四、六级统考，经验丰富的英语教师。他们在英语教学和实践中研究、总结出中国学生学英语的难点，深知学生在掌握同义短语中所遇到的困难。因此本书因势利导，特别适合准备四、六级统考和研究生入学考试及自学的读者，同时，也可以作为英语教师重要的参考书。本书每 30 组短语配有相应的练习题 30 道，供读者复习、巩固之用。


