

前 言

英语中有大量意义相同或相近的词或短语,这些词和短语有的差别比较明显,易于辨别;有的差别微妙,容易混淆;有的在意思上和用法上完全或基本相同,可以互换;有的在某些场合可以互换,而在另一些场合则不能互换;有的虽然意义相同,所要求的句子结构(搭配关系)却不同,如此等等。这些同义词、近义词的大量存在,既使英语语言丰富多采,同时,也给英语学习者带来不少困难。作者一向认为,学习语言要在一定的语言环境中学习。因此,本书对一些常用的同义词、近义词(519组共1721个单词)不但注意从概念上予以区分,更注重提供实例,使读者能够从实际运用中准确地感知、体察其异同,从而达到熟练掌握并能自如运用的目的。此外,本书对于这些词语常用的句型结构及搭配关系、使用场合等也给予了充分注意。作者认为本书具有以下几个特点:

重点和难点突出 在英语中有些单词或短语(如 announce, declare, pronounce, proclaim)尽管读者已经有所了解,但了解得还不够深刻、全面,且又不能与其同义词或近义词区别开来,作者对这些词进行了较为详细的辨析。另外,英语中还有两个或两个以上的单词拼写相似,而意义却截然不同(如 blush, flush, flash),作者对这类词或短语也进行了辨析。

结合辨析选择例句 每个词义后至少给出两个或两个以上的例句。在选择例句中,作者注重选择那些能够从语义和句法两个方面体现辨析项目中词汇差别的例句,这样使读者能够从实际运用中准确地感知、体察其异同,从而达到熟练掌握并能自如运用的目的。

书末附有索引,方便读者反查 在该索引中,作者将本书中每个辨析项中的除第一个单词以外的所有单词按照字母顺序列出,并给出该词所在辨析项的第一个单词,以便读者反查。
