

近年来,高考英语分数档距拉开的比较大,为分层次选拔人才提供了极大便利。然而,一些很有潜质的考生,因为较低的英语分数与理想的大学失之交臂而抱憾终身。"亡羊补牢,为时未晚",提高英语成绩的关键,就在于突破完型填空和提高阅读理解能力。众所周知,完形填空和阅读理解是高考试题中占分最多的题型(新课标卷I,70分)。学者研究普遍认为,影响完形填空和阅读理解的因素主要是语言知识(对词汇、句法分析能力)、阅读策略和技巧(全局把握文章的写作意图,掠读、扫读提取有效信息)和背景知识(涉及科普、人物传记、历史地理、环境、热点事件等)。

突破高考英语完形填空和阅读理解的基本策略是依据教材夯实基础,逐级提高,最佳的训练素材是历年经典高考真题和模拟试题。"操千曲而后晓声,观千剑而后识器"。鉴于此,本书依据最新高考考试大纲,根据近年宁夏新课标高考以来教师教学需求和学生突破现有英语水平瓶颈的需求,按照专题、体裁、难度精选了部分经典高考真题和模拟题,并配有答案和解析,旨在帮助高中学生更好地提高英语水平。

本书具有以下特色:

- 1. 试题经典。试题均精选自高考真题和各省、市、重点高中的模拟试题。这将有助于高中生了解并熟悉高考英语真题原貌(各小题保留了原卷中的分值),使考生做到知己知彼、融会贯通。通过经典试题积累词汇、总结答题规律,从而快速突破完形填空和阅读理解的瓶颈。
- 2. 体裁和题材多样化。选材遵循原汁原味的原则,贴近时代贴近生活,且大多语篇融汇了思想性和教育性。体裁多样化,包含记叙文、说明文和议论文等。题材有教育、卫生、健康、自然(动植物)和科学等方面的内容,贴近高中生生活,符合一般高中生的认识水平。
 - 3. 答案精准。参考答案解析准确、详细,有助于高中生更好地掌握答题技巧,规避失分。
 - 4. 方便实用。顺序由易到难,方便高中生系统地进行自我检测,避免了在选题方面浪费太多的时间。 希望所有使用本书的高中生都能从中受益,并期待着师生们的支持和批评!


