内容提要

本书是"中学英语 300 训练系列(拓展版)"之一,针对高中英语听力题型编写。书稿根据高中阶段英语听力的教学要求,分年级提供 30 套循序渐进的英语听力进阶训练。使读者在打好扎实的语言基础后,能够胸有成竹地应对高中英语学业考试、高考英语及各类同等水平英语测试。

本书适合高三年级学生使用。

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对于高中生来说,英语听力一直是一个巨大挑战。高考中,尽管听力的分值仅仅占英语总分的五分之一,但是它对整场英语考试所产生的重要性却是其他题型所无法相比的。听力测试的过程只有一次,就像一锤子买卖一样,考生不能反复阅读和思考;听力考试过程中发挥的好与不好对于后面的考试在心理上起着巨大的影响作用,它甚至关系着整场考试的成功与失败。因此考生要在英语高考中取得好成绩,首先在听力考试中就要得心应手。

为满足广大高中生快速适应高中教学对听力水平的要求,帮助他们在有限的时间内迅速提高听力理解能力,熟练掌握高中听力应试技巧,我们特邀研究高考命题多年,在上海市长期从事高中英语教学和研究的资深教师,为高中生在高中学习阶段熟悉和适应高考英语听力题型、解题要求和测试程序,顺利通过高考英语听力测试而编写了本套从书。

本套丛书按照高中各年级教学进度和要求分为高一、高二和高三三册。每册共 30 套练习,听力内容丰富全面,涉及日常生活、人文知识、科普常识、时事政治等各个方面。其听力材料新鲜、语言标准,兼顾了英美英语的特点。本书力求在内容、难度、题型及评分标准均与新课标的教学要求保持一致。设计的题型紧扣上海市高考英语听力题型,是高中生迅速提高听力水平、早日接近或达到高考水平的必备训练书。

本书限于编者水平有限,时间仓促,谬误之处敬请广大读者不吝赐教。
