



一、编写依据



前言

《大学金砖英语视听说教程》是以《大学英语课程要求》为指导,以大学生为读者 对象,以满足不同层次、个性化需求为理念编写的一套数字化教材。

本套视听说教程包括通用(1-2 册)、理工(3-4 册)、医药(3-4 册)、农林(3-4 册) 和社科(3-4 册),共十本,每本十个单元。每单元包括音频 3 个、视频 1 个,为了满足 英语听说机考的需要,我们在每个单元设立了 Internet Based CET Testing。

2. 教材文本及 Video & Audio 的录制

本套视听说教材文本语言生动、活泼,具有当代美语口语特点,同时在内容上又能满足大学生专业发展个性化需求。本套教材文本全部聘请美国外教执笔写作。第一、二册为通用教材,文本内容以日常口语、社会、文化内容为主。第三、四册分别为理工类、农林类、医药类和社科类,其内容以各类的个性为主。本套教材的全部音频、视频都由美籍教师录制,语音纯正,语言标准、生动。

3. 在线平台

本套视听说教材配有 MP3 光盘,提供文本的音频及视频,并开了发了"英语听力在线测评系统"、"英语四、六级机考在线热身系统"等,不仅所有教材的听力练习可以在线自测评估(八项功能),而且金砖英语网站可以向师生提供大学音频、视频在线学习、基于计算机的自我测评平台。立体化的学习资源有利于学生英语听力的迅速提高。

4. 使用建议

1) 这套视听说教材在编写时,考虑到大学一年级有过级考试的需求,我们编写的《视听说》第1册、第2册为通用型,供大一的两个学期使用;第3册、第4册分别为"农林"、"理工"、"医药"、"社科"四类,为个性型,可分别供给个性化需求的院校大学英语教学使用。




