Lucy and her assistant hid in their car until the angry bees had calmed down. Next, Lucy searched out 3 (elephant) families in Samburu National Reserve in northern Kenya and put a speaker in a tree close to each family.

From a 4 (distant), Lucy switched on the pre-recorded sound of angry bees while at the same time recording the elephants with a video camera. Half the elephant groups left the area within ten seconds. Out of the 5 (group), only one group ignored the sound of the angry 6 (bee).
