

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前 言

本书依据教育部《高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲》和《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》(试行)编写,旨在帮助高职高专学生顺利通过高等学校英语应用能力(B级)考试。书中收录高等学校英语应用能力 B级全真模拟试卷 10套。全书共分为三大部分:第一部分为高等学校英语应用能力考试(B级)模拟题;第二部分为高等学校英语应用能力(B级)参考答案与解析。

第一部分包括 10 套高等学校英语应用能力(B级)全真模拟试题。

在第二部分中,编者对高等学校英语应用能力考试(B级)的每一种题型进行了详尽的剖析,并进一步提出了各种实用的解题思路和技巧,可以帮助考生在较短的时间内正确把握真题的命题原则和规律、题型特征和应试策略。例如,在试卷 Part I 听力理解部分,不仅提供了每小题的参考答案和解析,还提供了听力原文,可以帮助学生了解听力文本的特点和答题技巧;又如,在试卷 Part III 阅读理解部分,在提供参考译文的同时,按短文内容提供了题型分析,以便帮助学生抓住要点,读懂全文。

本书听力部分配有 MP3 光盘,便于学生对听力部分进行强化训练。

本书根据海南各高校的高职高专学生英语学习的特点,由海南省大学英语教学指导委员会组编,编者是来自海南各高职高专学校的英语教师,他们在教学第一线,了解学生的学习情况。因此,本书有很强的针对性,真正做到有的放矢。

由于编者水平有限、书中难免出现纰漏、敬请读者和专家指正。
