《新版英语小题库》丛书目前分高中4册,初中4册,旨在通过对学生的有效指导和训练,达到逐步提高学生英语水平的目的。本书是此套丛书中的一本。

本书是由丛书中原《英语语法小题库》改版而来。原书从 1994 年初版以来广受读者好评,新版在原来的基础上推陈出新,对中学阶段必须掌握的语法知识,如名词、代词、冠词、介词、形容词、副词等的用法及作用,动词的时态和语态,句子的种类和类型,分 12 章练习,并根据高考的要求,在第 14 章提供了 50 篇语法填空题库,对重点和难点题目在参考答案中作了详细的解释和说明。本书开篇提供了一套自测题供学生检查自身对高中英语语法的掌握程度,找到自身的薄弱环节,更有针对性地开展学习。全书最后一章的自测题供大家检测学习成果。学生通过本书的练习,对高考语法的巩固和复习可起到事半功倍的效果。
