为了贯彻《中共中央、国务院关于深化教育改革全面推进素质教育的决定》精神,落实《面向21世纪教育振兴行动计划》中提出的职业教育课程改革和教材建设规划,根据教育部关于《中等职业教育国家规划教材申报、立项及管理意见》(教职成 [2001] 1号)的精神,我们组织力量对实现中等职业教育培养目标和保证基本教学规格起保障作用的德育课程、文化基础课程、专业技术基础课程和80个重点建设专业主干课程的教材进行了规划和编写,国家规划教材将陆续提供给各类中等职业学校选用。

国家规划教材是根据教育部最新颁布的德育课程、文化基础课程、专业技术基础课程和80个重点建设专业主干课程的教学大纲(课程教学基本要求)编写,并经全国中等职业教育教材审定委员会审定。新教材全面贯彻素质教育思想,从社会发展对高素质劳动者和中初级专门人才需要的实际出发,注重对学生的创新精神和实践能力的培养。新教材在理论体系、组织结构和阐述方法等方面均作了一些新的尝试。新教材实行一纲多本,努力为教材选用提供比较和选择,满足不同学制、不同专业和不同办学条件的教学需要。

再版说明

《商务英语听说》是面向中等职业学校学生编写的一本教材。该教材从外贸业务岗位(群)对商务英语口语沟通能力的要求出发,选取商务接待和商务谈判各环节为主要内容,并按照外贸业务流程来进行编排。同时为拓展学生知识面,提高学生综合素养,还编排了六课新闻英语。练习的形式灵活多样,听与说结合,同步训练。

该教材自2002年出版以来,受到了广大读者的欢迎。2008年对其进行了修订。此次,应出版社邀请,再次进行修订。为使该教材更适合中等职业学校学生使用,并进一步加强商务环境下的英语听说能力的培养,同时对原有过时的内容进行更新,在此次修订时,除保留原有特色外,主要做了如下改进:

- 1. 每一课都设置了 Aims 部分,明确每一课的能力目标,即通过这一课的学习要学会处理什么问题,提高哪一方面的能力,这样更有利于学生自学。
- 2. 每一课的 Part C Speaking 部分中增加了会话英汉互译或会话补充练习,旨在加强培养学生的英语口语交际能力和英汉互译能力。对原有句型练习进行了适当的调整增补。News Report 中增加了 Part C Speaking 话题讨论练习,要求根据 Part B Listening 中听到的内容所涉及的话题进行讨论,以此锻炼学生的自我表达和沟通的能力。
- 3. 更新了所有的新闻部分。并针对目前商务活动和国际贸易形势的变化, 对各章节中已经过时陈旧的内容进行了更新。
 - 4. 对较长的对话内容进行了适当的删减。
 - 5. 对语言进行了修改, 使之更规范、更准确。


