The teenagers have created a secret language to stop adults knowing what they are up to, using slang words to keep parents and employers in the dark about their social activities such as partying and drinking.

Instead of writing they are drunk, teens post "Getting MWI(getting mad with it)", also known as "steaming". "People" and "cool" can be respectively written as "Ppl" and "Kwl". "Ridneck" pronounced "redneck", is used to describe embarrassment—in that it will cause them to have a red neck.

Lisa Whittaker, who conducted the study about teens' using social networking cite *Bebo*, cited the example of one young girl named Kelly who was <u>sacked</u> after her boss found pictures or her drinking on the website. She said, "Young people often distort(使 变形) the languages they use. By doing it they are able to communicate with their in-group and hide the content from the out-group. "The language used on *Bebo* seems to go beyond abbreviations (缩写词) that are commonly used in text messaging, such as removing all the vowels. This is not just bad spelling, which would suggest literacy(读写能力) issues, but an attempt to create misspelled words.

Lisa said, "Kelly feels very bitter about losing her job. She likes to drink at the weekends, even though she is still under the legal age. She thinks her personal life is separate from her working life. Young people give each other recognition for not only going to college and having a job but also engaging in social activities such as drinking and smoking. Other people may think that a young person should be labeled a delinquent( 违 法者) for drinking alcohol while under the legal age. However, these young people are able to recognize -each other for both socially desirable and undesirable behaviours. "

She went on, "Social networking sites like Bebo provide young people with an opportunity to gain informal positive recognition from their peer group. The total number of friends you are connected with indicates your popularity. For young people, a low number of friends, for example, less than 500, is a sign that you are not very popular. "
