写给孩子和家人的话

阅读是打开世界的一扇窗户。英语阅读是充满乐趣的学习活动。

英语阅读习惯的培养要从娃娃抓起。只有在儿童时期打下良好的阅读基础,才能养成受益终身的阅读习惯。遗憾的是,英语阅读理解却成了困扰很多小学生和家长的难题。

因此,编写一套既能满足小学生英语课外阅读需求,又能提高他们阅读理解能力的辅导书就显得非常必要。本丛书共5册,每册设50个单元共100篇独立的小短文,主要有以下几个特点。

一、趣味性强

兴趣是最好的老师。本丛书集中选取了动物故事、童话故事、儿歌童谣、语言故事等富有趣味性的内容,符合小学生的认知规律,能让小学生在阅读中体验无穷的乐趣。

二、信息量大

未知世界总是充满吸引力。本丛书注重新颖性、知识性,选取了经典地道的文化风俗、地理风情、人物故事、科普知识等内容,能让小学生在阅读中获取大量信息,拓展知识面。

三、扩充词汇

词汇是阅读的基础。本丛书每篇短文附有“能量补充站”栏目,给出生词及解释。通过阅读,小学生的词汇量在不知不觉中得到了扩大,其学习效果明显优于机械的单词记忆。

四、巩固语法

语法是学习的难点。目前小学英语课堂教学有淡化语法教学的倾向,这增加了语法学习的困难。通过阅读原汁原味的短文,小学生可在潜移默化中学习和巩固语法知识。

五、提升能力

本丛书的定位是课外阅读理解,即选材与课本存在差异,难度略高于课堂要求,着眼于提升小学生的英语综合运用能力,特别适合周末进阶学习。

需要指出的是,本丛书大多数文章选自外文原版材料,且题材丰富,可能部分小读者会觉得个别短文生词数量稍多。小读者大可不必望而却步,首先,“能量补充站”已列出大多较难的词,不影响阅读;其次,对照参考译文,理解原文毫无困难。在真实的语境下进行浸润式阅读,读者能在不知不觉当中提高自身的语言能力。当然,这也意味着本丛书中的短文也值得在周末以外的时间好好研读。
