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· 前言

一、内容经典,所有篇目均选自历年中、高考真题。我们尤其注重英文的地道和原汁原味,剔除了某些由中国人撰写的、带有明显汉语思维痕迹的中、高考文章。

二、循序渐进,按内容的难度进行分级。整套丛书从初一至高中难度逐渐抬 升,让阅读者的英语水平在不知不觉中得到提高。

三、疑难词、关键词注释,力求重点突出。特别是给出了相应的例句,便于阅读者彻底掌握这些词汇。

四、全文翻译,彻底解决读不懂、读不透、练习做了很多可水平提升缓慢的问题。您可能早已注意到,超过99%的中学英语教辅书籍是没有翻译的,为什么?因为翻译的难度最大、对编者的挑战最高。所以我们查阅了大量资料,尽力提供最为准确、流畅的译文,力求使同学们读一篇就彻底消化一篇。

五、采用五篇完形填空的周计划模式,并在周末补充生词强化及幽默故事。全书共20周,一周之内每天读一篇,题量不大便于坚持,以达到循序渐进的目的。

需要说明的是,本次修订对高中阶段的内容做了整合,原来的9册合并为现在的3册,每册中的基础篇对应高一,提高篇对应高二,冲刺篇对应高三。由于新近推行的高考英语改革试点省份试行一年两考,允许学生提前参加高考,所以这样的编排方式便于不同程度的学生根据自身情况灵活掌握进度,也减轻了学生的负担,只此一本,便能让你从容应对高考!
