前 言

为配合广大初中生迎接中考,根据国家教育部颁布的《中学英语教学大纲》《全日制初级中学英语教科书》,作者紧密结合近年来的全国多个省市中考英语试卷,精心编写了这本《初中英语阅读与完形2000题》。

"阅读理解"与"完形填空"是每年全国各个省市中考英语试卷中的必考项目,是对广大初中生英语综合能力和整体水平的全面检测。它不仅要求学生掌握足够的词汇和必备的语法知识,同时也是在检查学生阅读理解、逻辑分析等英语语言综合应用能力。

全书由四部分组成:第一部分为完形填空,第二部分为首字母填空及综合填空,第三部分为阅读理解,共计184篇练习,最后附录为参考答案及详解。

作者在全书的每一部分中都精心编排了最近两年全国各地多个 省市的中考英语试卷真题,将中考真题和模拟题有机结合起来,目的 是让广大读者找出自身差距,发现不足。全书的所有习题均给出了参 考答案及详解,以便广大读者自行检查学习效果。作者在挑选书中短 文时,力求将时尚与传统、知识与趣味有机结合起来。学生学习本书 不仅有助于提高应试能力,同时也能拓宽知识面,增长见识,可谓一举 两得。
