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序

瀋陽背倚長白山麓，面向渤海之濱，是中國的工業重鎮，東北地區的經濟、文化中心和交通樞紐。她不僅是一座以機電工業為主的綜合性工業城市，又是一座古蹟遍佈點綴其中的國家歷史文化名城。

FOREWORD

Shenyang, Sitting against the Changbai Mountain and facing the Bohai Sea, is one of China's major cities for heavy industry. It is the communications hub as well as the cultural and economic center of the Northeast. It is not only a multi-producing industrial city with machine building and electric equipment production as leading industries, but also one of the country's famous historical and cultural cities with many places of historical interests.

Shenyang has a long history and a splendid culture. More than 7,000 years ago, the ancestors of the Chinese nation created with their wisdom the immortal Xinle Culture in Shenyang. A rich historical and cultural heritage is left behind from the Spring and Autumn Period, Warring States Period up to the Liao, Jin, Yuan and Ming Dynasties. The Qing empire, China's last feudal dynasty, took Shenyang as its "Rise-of-Dragon-Land". A total of 405 historical sites and cultural relics, above- or underground are scattered all over the city. The Shenyang Imperial Palace looking splendid in green and gold, Fuling and Zhaoling embraced by towering pines and cypresses are like glistening diamonds decorating this beautiful city. The Shenyang Imperial Palace has a huge collection of relics from the imperial palace court and arts and crafts of the Qing Dynasty, which provides valuable information for the study and research of the Qing-Dynasty culture and art. This colourful historical and cultural treasure has added lustre to the city of Shenyang.

Since the 3rd Plenary Session of the 11th National Congress of CPC, the Shenyang municipal committee of CPC and the municipal government have earnestly upheld the four cardinal principles and implemented the policy of opening to the outside world and invigorating domestic economy. Consequently the national economy is on a new upsurge and the ancient city is changing dramatically with each passing day. Its rich resources of cultural relics are being exploited and utilized in all ways. 前言

瀋陽是一座歷史悠久的文化古城，在八千五百平方公里的土地上，居住着漢、滿、蒙、回、朝鮮、錫伯等民族。

早在七千多年前的新石器時代，我們的祖先就在這裏勞動生息，春秋戰國、漢、遼、金、元、明各朝都在瀋陽設城。清王朝在此建都，為瀋陽留下許多名勝古蹟和珍貴文物。因此一九八六年國務院公佈瀋陽為歷史文化名城。為了滿足各界的願望，我們彙集了一百六十餘幅彩色照片，編輯了這本《瀋陽文物》畫冊。

第一部份，名勝古蹟。主要選有遼代渾壯高聳的無垢淨光舍利塔，清初的東塔和北塔法輪寺，先於瀋陽城的長安寺，錫伯族的家廟太平寺、喇嘛教的實勝寺、佛教的般若寺、道教的太清宮。還有努爾哈赤、皇太極的陵墓，福陵和昭陵。瀋陽故宮是我國保存最完整的兩座宮殿之一。同時還有中共滿洲省委舊址，周恩來少年讀書舊址，張氏帥府和抗美援朝烈士陵園等一批紀念建築。

第二部份，文物珍品。主要介紹了瀋陽故宮博物院收藏的宮廷遺物、名家書畫、陶瓷、琺瑯和漆器等。

第三部份，出土文物。精選了聞名中外的新石器時代早期的新樂文化，春秋戰國時期的鄭家洼子青銅短劍墓出土的青銅器，漢魏時期的陶器，遼代的石茵鎮、龜硯、舍利塔內壁畫和遼三彩瓷器，金元時期的瓷器及窖藏。

在編輯過程中受到了瀋陽故宮博物院，瀋陽新樂遺址博物館及有關部門的大力支持和幫助，在此表示謝意。

由於我們的水平有限，可能會有諸多的欠缺和錯誤，望廣大讀者給予批評指正。

PREFACE

Shenyang is an ancient city with a long history behind. Her 8,500 square kilometers of land is inhabited by the nationalities of the Han, Manchu, Mongol, Hui, Korea, Xibo, etc.

Historical relics indicate that our ancestors have lived and laboured here since 7,000 years ago in the neolithic period. In the Spring and Autumn Period, Warring States Period, and the Han, Liao, Jin, Yuan, Ming Dynasties, local governments were set up here in Shenyang. The Qing Dynasty made Shenyang once its capital, which left behind many places of historical interests and valuable cultural relics. Shenyang was thus designated by the State Council in 1986 as one of the national historical and cultural cities. To satisfy the wishes of all circles of people, we have collected more than 160 coloured photographs and compiled the "Cultural Relics in Shenyang".

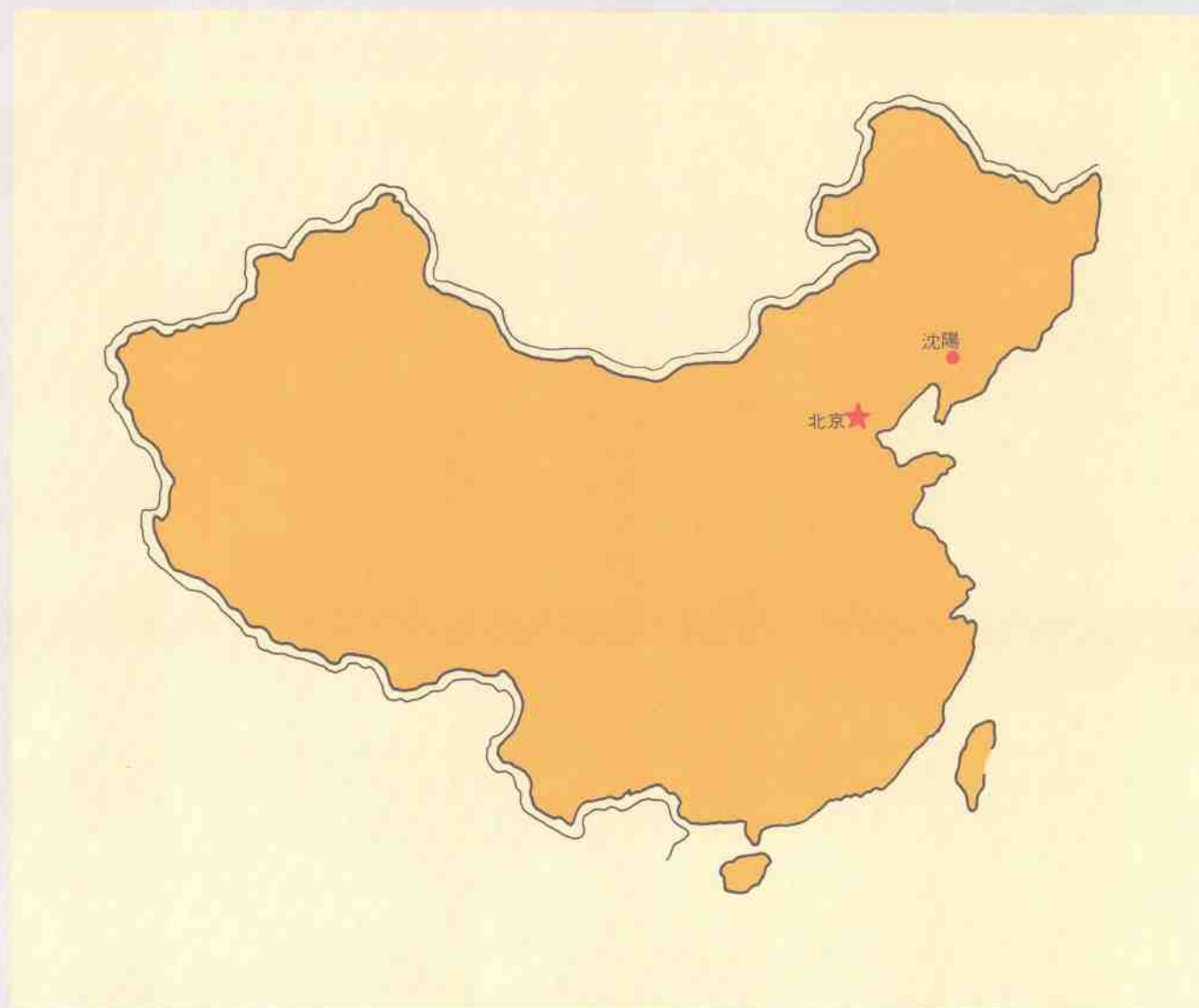
Section I, HISTORICAL SITES, shows the Liao-Dynasty Sheli Pagoda, the East Pagoda, North Pagoda and Falun Temple of the Qing Dynasty, Changan Temple built before Shenyang city, Taiping Temple-family temple of Xibo nationality, Shisheng Temple of Lamaism, Banro Temple of Buddhism, and Taiqing Temple of Taoism. In the collection there are also Fuling and Zhaoling, the tombs of Nuerhachi and Huangtaiji, Shenyang Imperial Palace-one of the only two palace complexes still standing intact in China. Among the commemorative sites are the site of the former CPC Committee of Manchu Province, the school where late Premier Zhou Enlai once studied, the residence of Marshal Zhang Zuolin, and the Mausoleum of Martyrs in the War to Resist US and Aid Korea.

Section II, RARE AND VALUABLE CULTURAL RELICS, includes the collection of the relics from the imperial palace court by the Shenyang Imperial Palace Museum, paintings and calligraphy by famous artists, pottery and porcelaine, cloisonne, lacquer ware, etc.

Section III, UNEARTHED CULTURAL RELICS, describes the renowned Xinle Culture representing the early stage of the neolithic period, the bronze ware of the Spring and Autumn and Warring States Periods unearthed from the Short Bronze Sword Tomb at Zhengjiawazi, the pottery from the Han and Wei Dynasties, lion-shaped stone paperweight, tortoise inkstone, the murals inside the Sheli Pagoda, the famille verte porcelain from the Liao Dynasty, porcelain and buried objects from the Jin and Yuan Dynasties.

We wish to acknowledge gratefully the Shenyang Imperial Palace Museum, Shenyang Xinle Neolithic Site Museum and other department concerned for their generous support and help in the process of compilation.

Map of People's Republic of China

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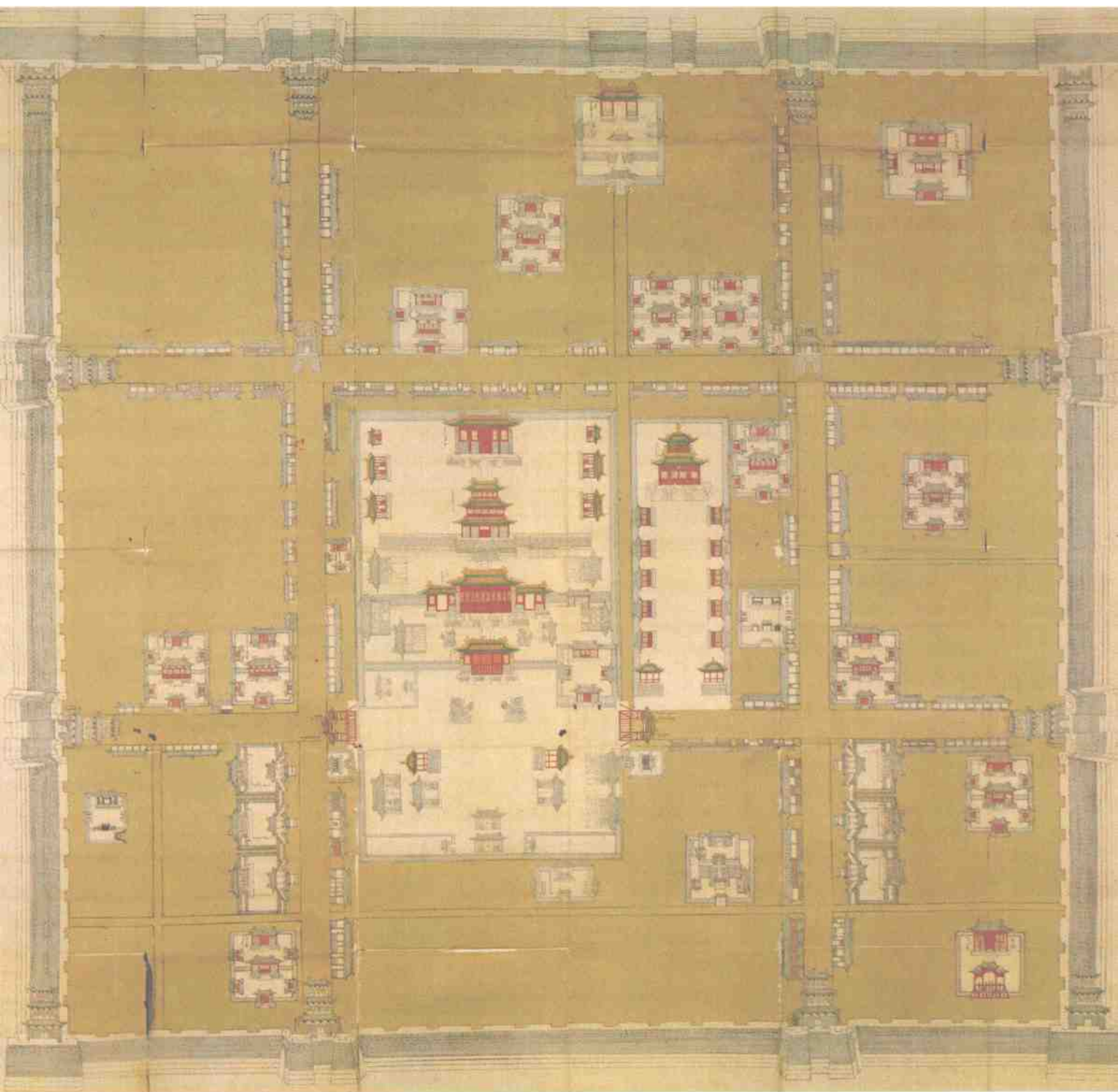
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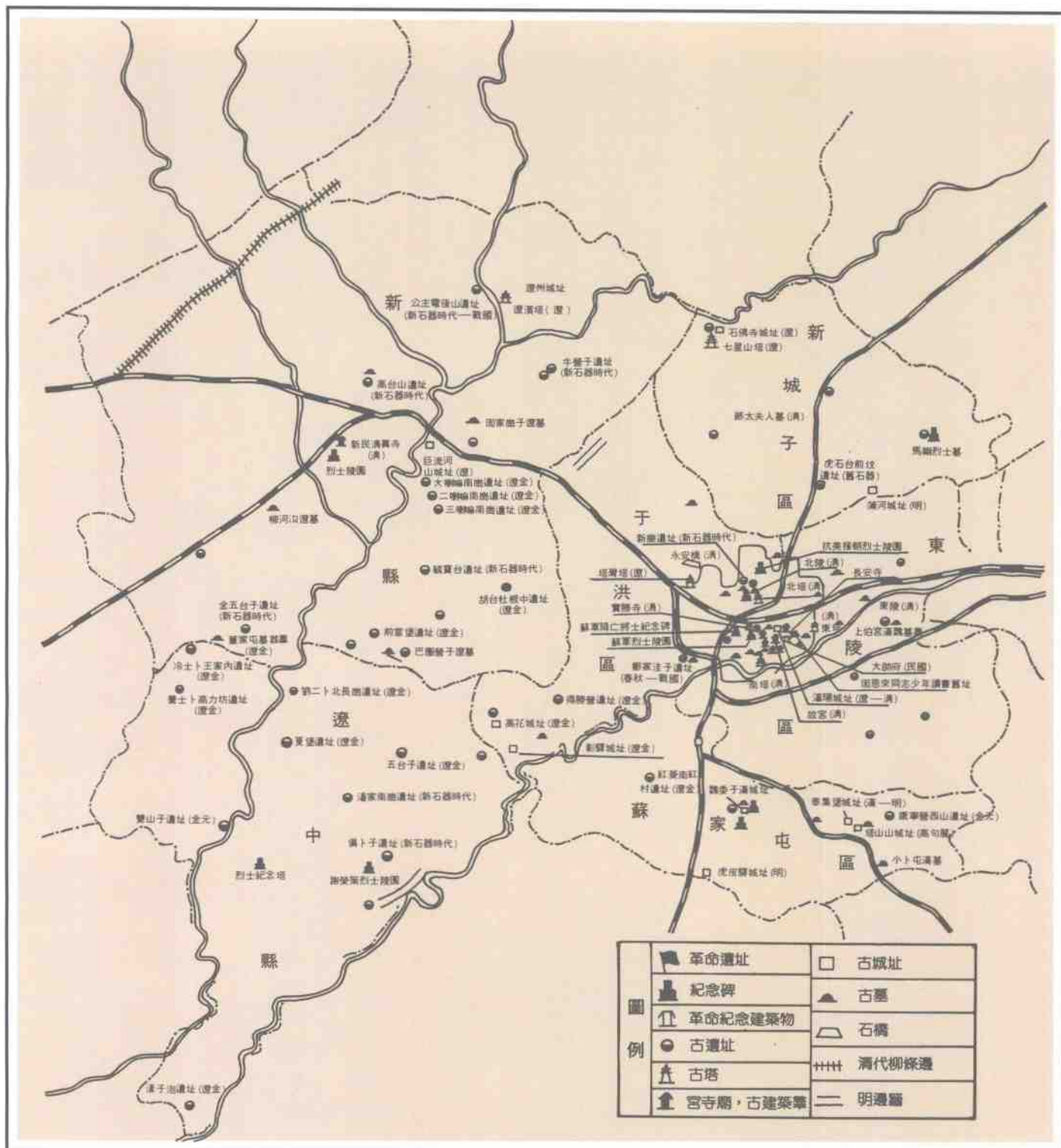
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瀋陽市文物古蹟分佈圖

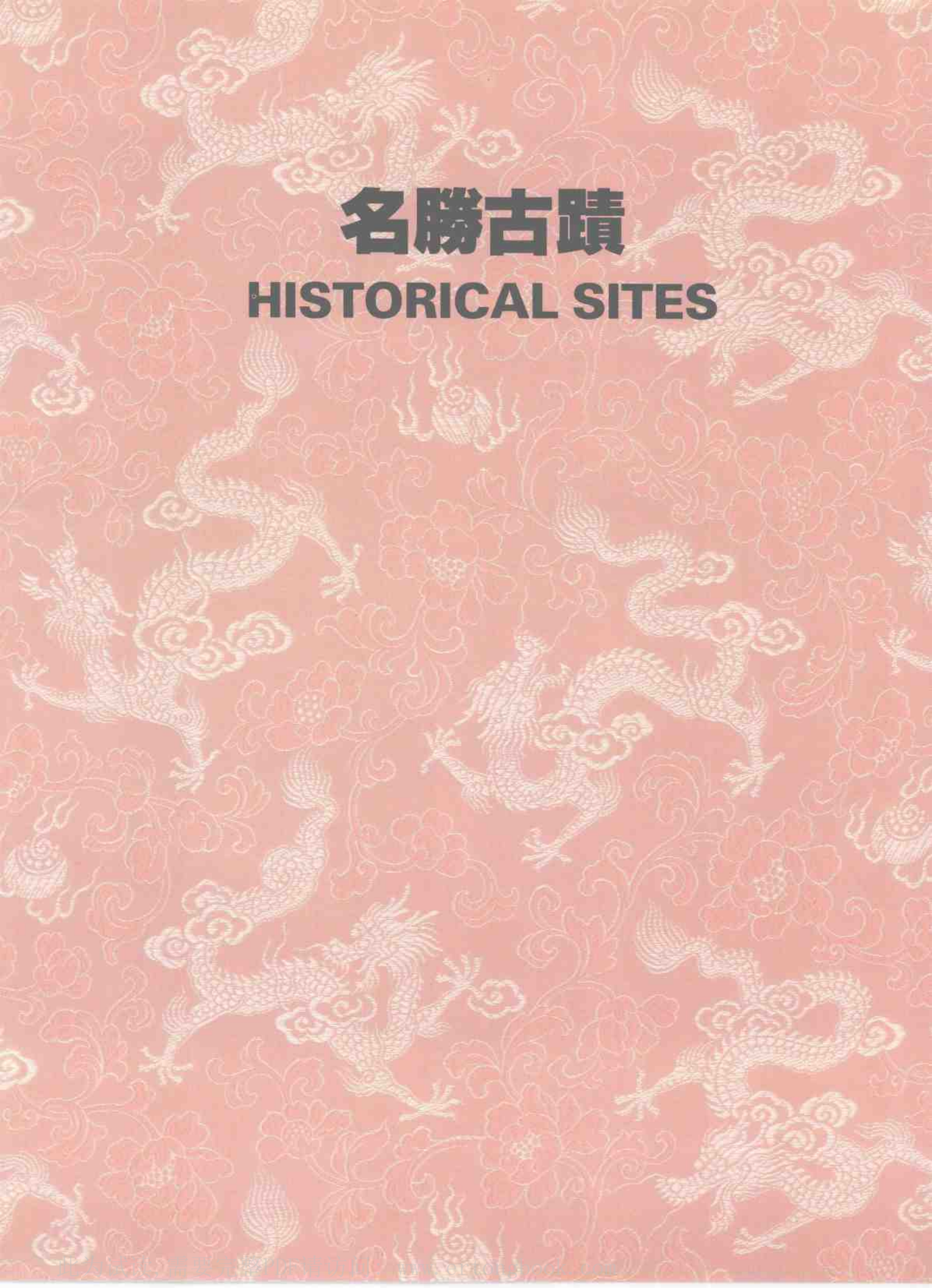
