## 前 言

国家基础教育课程改革启动至今已有九年,新的教育理念正被越来越多的教育工作者和社会人士所接受。我国基础教育事业正经历着一次深刻的变革,这一变革的核心,对于教师来说,就是转换角色定位;对于学生来说,就是改变学习方式。

为帮助学生掌握英语基础知识和英语学习方法、提高英语学习能力,以适应中学全面实施素质教育,提高教育质量,根据《普通高中课程标准》(实验稿)的基本要求,经过认真研讨,精心设计,我们编写了这套独具特色的、体现高中英语新课标理念的《高中英语同步评价手册》。

《高中英语同步评价手册》是经教育部审定通过的重庆大学版《高中英语》教材的重要组成部分,与每册学生用书相配合。本书与《英语 4》教材相配套。书中提供了大量的、围绕教材中心话题的语言训练活动,交际性和任务型活动,强调了语言的积累,知识的归纳、总结以及自我评价、学习策略。

#### 编写原则:

- 1. 初高中自然衔接
- 2. 练习内容与教材同步
- 3. 知识不断复现、活用
- 4. 活动设计体现层次性
- 5. 注重综合语言能力培养
- 6. 应试与素质培养相结合

#### 体系结构:

以学生用书每个单元的七个板块为参照,所有练习题和活动内容完全与教材内容同步。主要包括以下七个部分:

- 1. Previewing 通过词汇学习和信息查找,指导学生对课文有关内容进行预习。
- 2. Language Focus 通过单项选择等三种题型,重点复习巩固课文中重要的词汇、句型等内容。
- 3. **Practising and Producing** 通过单项选择等两种题型,重点复习巩固本单元要求掌握的语法内容,试题设计凸显语法的交际性原则。
- 4. Listening and Speaking 通过听对话选择、听短文填空、讨论问题三种题型,综合训练学生听和说的能力。
  - 5. Writing 通过与主题内容相关的书面表达练习,训练学生写的能力,并体现过程性写作指导。
- 6. **Further Reading** 通过完形填空和阅读理解两种题型的训练,渗透阅读技巧,培养学生综合运用语言的能力。此部分是对教材阅读材料的有益补充和延伸。

我们在每课的 Further Reading 中提供了两篇与主题相关的阅读材料。每次阅读一篇短文并在作

理解测试题时,同学们可统计一下阅读速度和理解正确率,长期坚持这种训练,能收到明显的效果。公式如下:

阅读速度 = 所读材料词数 ÷ 阅读时间,单位为"词/分钟" 阅读理解度(即正确率) = 答对试题数 ÷ 总试题数 ×100%

7. **单元检测题** 以100分钟的一套试题,通过单项选择等六种题型,对本单元要求掌握的重要词汇、句型、语法等内容进行检测,试题设计重点凸显检测内容与教材内容同步的编写原则。此外,为方便学生阶段性回顾所学内容,本书附有一套期末综合检测题。

《高中英语同步评价手册》由中学英语教研员、有丰富教学经验的重点中学的一线英语特级教师、英语高级教师以及高校教师编写而成。但由于成书时间仓促,加之我们水平有限,且本套书的编写体例又是一种全新的尝试,不妥之处,敬请读者在使用中提出宝贵意见和建议,以便再版时修订。
