### 前 言

2004年6月教育部颁布了《大学英语课程教学要求》,把"大学阶段的英语教学要求分为三个层次,即一般要求、较高要求和更高要求"。根据一般要求,学生"掌握的总词汇量应达到4,500个单词和700个词组,其中2,000个单词为积极词汇,即要求学生能够在认知的基础上学会熟练运用";根据较高要求,学生"掌握的总词汇量应达到5,500个单词和1,200个词组(包括中学和一般要求应该掌握的积极词汇)为积极词汇";根据更高要求,学生"掌握的总词汇量应达到6,500个单词和1,700个词组(包括中学和一般要求和较高要求应该掌握的识点,其中2,500个单词(包括一般要求和较高要求应该掌握的积极词汇)为积极词汇"。

众所周知,学好大学英语的最基本条件之一就是要掌握《大学英语课程教学要求》所规定的大学英语词汇及一定数量的词组。为了帮助学习大学英语的人员更好地了解、学习、记忆和掌握《大学英语课程教学要求》所规定必须掌握的大学英语的各层次考试词组,达到大学英语各级别相应的词组水平,为提高英语水平打好基础,我们特地编写了《大学英语四、六级词组例释手册》。本手册是根据《大学英语四、六级词组例释手册》。本手册是根据《大学英语课程教学要求》对大学英语三个层次水平应该掌握的词组要求而编写的具有实用价值的词组学习、记忆手册。

《大学英语课程教学要求(大学英语词组表)》实际收录词组 1,875 个。我们根据大学英语四、六级考试的实际情况增列了 518 个词组,共计 2,393 个

词组。

《大学英语四、六级词组例释手册》将三个层次要求的 1,700 个词组以及增列的 518 个词组采用以词组的中心词为序的字母表 (alphabet)排序方式编排,如果中心词相同,则以第一个单词的字母顺序排列,给出每个词组的常用词义,并按各词组主要词义配一个例句。为了便于使用者查询,我们特地编排了词组索引。具有袖珍词组词典的作用。

为了区别各阶段的词组,"一般要求"的词组中其中心词属于中学阶段应掌握的词组不标注任何符号,其中心词属于大学阶段应掌握的词组前标有星号";中心词属于"较高要求"的词组前标有五角星★;中心词属于"更高要求"的词组前标有三角形▲,其标示符号与《大学英语课程教学要求(词汇表)》的标示符号基本一致。

《大学英语四、六级词组例释手册》由李跃平、杨廷君主编。裴光兰、凌民、谢海燕、吴迎春、余红卫、韦琴红等同志参加了部分内容的编写工作。浙江大学外语学院邵永真教授认真地审阅了全书、并提出了宝贵的修改意见,西南民族大学外国语学院和宁波大学外国语学院在本书的编写中给予了大力的支持,在此一并表示衷心的感谢。

由于时间仓促和编者的水平所限,书中恐有不妥之处,恳请使用该手册的读者提出宝贵的批评和建议,以便使该书日臻完善。
