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Chapter 1

见 面 告 别

Hello!

你好！

Hello! Li Yong. Hello! Tao Hong. Hello! I'm Michelle. Hello! ... 你好，李永。你好，陶虹。你好！我是米歇尔。你好！……“Hello”是最常用、最轻松的见面问候语。不管是旧友还是新朋，不管在电梯里，还是在大街上，不管是有约而见，还是萍水相逢……一声“Hello”会在瞬间把人们之间的距离拉近，温馨、愉悦的感觉油然而生。

You: Hello!

He: Hello!

你：你好！

他：你好！

You: Hello! Mary.

She: Hello! Li Yong.

你：你好！玛丽。

她：你好！李永。

You: Hello!

He: Good evening!

你：你好！

他：晚上好！

Other useful expressions

☆ 喂！

Hello/Hi!

☆ 早上好！

Good morning! /Morning!

☆ 下午好！

Good afternoon!

☆ 晚上好！

Good evening!

☆ 晚安！

Good night! /Night!

☆ 你好！

How do you do?

Notes

- * “Hello”除了“你好”的意思以外，还有“喂”的意思。用于打电话或接电话，或用在句子开头，引起他人的注意。
- * “Hi!”是“Hello!”的同义句，但比“Hello!”更显随便，用于非正式场合。
- * “Good morning!”一般用于从黎明到中午 12 点这一时间段的相互问候。
- * “Good afternoon!”通常用于中午 12 点到下午 6 点或日落这一时间段的相互问候。
- * 晚上见面时不用“Good night!”问候。“Good night!”意为“晚安”，是晚上告别时的招呼用语。
- * “How do you do?”含有“久仰！”的意思。用于初次见面。
- * 以上问候语的答语与问候语相同。

Hello! My name is Tao Hong.

你好！我叫陶虹。

将自己的名字告诉对方，并询问对方的名字，是初次见面必不可少的礼仪。告诉对方自己的名字的英文表达是：“My name is ~.”或“I'm ~.”询问对方名字的英文表达为：“What's your name, please?”或“May I have your name?”有时，为了慎重起见，还可以要求对方将名字拼写一遍，以免喊错名字而尴尬和不悦。

Dialogues

You: Hello! My name is Tao Hong.

May I have your name?

He: Hello! Tao Hong.

My name is Jack.

你：你好！我叫陶虹。

你叫什么名字？

他：你好！陶虹。

我叫杰克。

You: Hi! I'm Tao Hong.

What's your name, please?

She: Hi! Tao Hong.

I'm Cindy Waters.

You: Can you spell it, please?

She: Yes. C-I-N-D-Y, Cindy,

W-A-T-E-R-S, Waters.
