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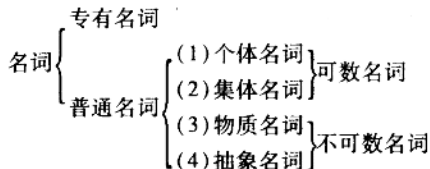
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基础训练一 名词、数词和冠词

【解题指导】

名词和冠词是每年高考中的必考语法项目。名词常结合其他项目一起考查,涉及面极广,考查要点有词语辨析、名词的数(可数与不可数、单数与复数)与冠词及修饰语的搭配等。近年来还出现了直接以名词为考查对象的单项选择题;并在高考阅读理解中,考查常用名词在文章中的准确意义。名词的分类如下:



冠词分为定冠词(the)和不定冠词(a, an)。冠词的考查有以下特点:考查定冠词和不定冠词的基本用法;考查a和an的不同用法;考查零冠词的用法。近几年高考中更强调在具体语境中冠词的使用,将冠词的一般规律和特殊现象结合起来考查。

高考中对数词的考查不太多,数词包括基数词(one, two, three...),序数词(first, second, third...),分数词($1/3$ one third, $3/5$ three fifths),小数(0.4 zero point four, 7.13 seven point one three)、百分数(1% one percent, 85% eighty-five percent),但我们仍应掌握数词的基本用法和一些特殊之处。

学习名词和冠词应注意以下几点:

1. 名词的可数与不可数,既要了解名词数的变化的一般规律,更要记住一些常用的特殊用法。
2. 名词的可数与不可数不是绝对的,有些不可数名词(物质名词和抽象名词)在许多情况下可变为可数名词。如:coffee 咖啡, a coffee 一杯咖啡; paper 纸, a fine paper 一种优质纸; pleasure 愉快, a pleasure 一件快乐的事,等等。
3. 有些名词只代表复数,如: police, cattle 等;有些名词只代表单数,如: traffic, scenery 等;有些名词用单数复数意义不同,如: air(空气), airs(摆架子); look(看), looks(外貌)等。
4. 掌握不定冠词和定冠词的一些特殊用法。

- (1) 不定冠词用在专有名词前起到具体化的作用,如: a Mr. Brown 一个叫布朗的先生; a Ford 一辆福特汽车。
- (2) 定冠词用于形容词、分词前表示一类人。如: the poor 穷人; the living 活着的人; the injured 受伤的人。
- (3) 定冠词用于姓氏复数前表示一家人。如: the Smiths 史密斯一家人。
- (4) 注意用不定冠词的固定短语,如: at a loss, as a result 等;用定冠词的固定短语,如: the other day, in the end 等;不用冠词的固定短语,如: catch cold, by turns 等。

形容词和副词应用广泛,用法复杂,是高考的重要测试点。要提高正确运用形容词和副词的运用能力,必须在练习中多加体会。在测试中应注意以下几点:

1. 注意在具体语境中形容词和副词的准确含义。
2. 注意不同搭配或不同句型的综合运用。
3. 注意不同固定搭配的区别。
4. 注意语法知识与实际运用能力的有机结合。

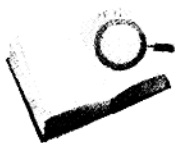

基础训练三 代词、连词和介词

【解题指导】

代词是英语高考试题中单项选择和短文改错题考查频率较高的项目,主要考查人称代词、物主代词、指示代词、反身代词和不定代词。在学习代词的时候,要充分了解代词的分类,熟练掌握各类代词的用法和差别;在语篇中,要弄清楚代词的指代对象;在平时的练习时,要有意识地多做一点相关的选择题、填空题和改错题;要注重代词使用的语言环境。

介词和连词都属于虚词,是每年高考中的必考内容,常出现在单项选择题、完形填空题和短文改错题中。因此,在学习过程中,要注意介词和连词不同的差别,还有,同一个词用作介词和连词时后面所加内容的不同;还要注意介词和连词的习惯用法和固定搭配。

一、代词命题规律及应试策略:

1. 考查角度有两个:一是其意义和功能差别,二是其语法特征的差异。
2. 试题注重情景干扰,而且题干的语义结构越来越复杂。
3. 代词的相关知识庞杂,而且在使用中又颇为频繁,因此建议考生认真对待。
4. 首先要从整体上把握代词的知识,了解代词的一般用法,更要重点掌握几组易混词的用法。

二、连词命题规律及应试策略:

1. 并列连词、转折连词:and, or, but, so 等。
2. 连接状语从句的连词,尤其是:when, while, before, as 的特殊用法。
3. 引导名词性从句的连词。
4. 特殊连词如:the moment, directly, immediately, (the) last / next time 等。

三、介词命题规律及应试策略:

1. 在具体语境中正确选用介词。
2. in, with, by 表示工具或方式。
3. at, for, with 表示原因。
4. but, except 和 besides 表示“除了”。
5. with / without 复合结构。
6. 介词 + 介词短语,如 from behind the door, except on rainy days, instead of on foot 等。
7. 介词是英语中最活跃的词类之一,使用频率相当高,其用法多而杂。一个介词有多种不同的用法,一个相近的意思又可以用不同的介词表示。所以必须逐一学会每个介词的用法,弄清楚易混介词的用法异同,能根据语境和交际条件灵活运用介词。此外,介词与动词、名词、形容词的习惯搭配也不能忽视。
