

本书延续了由 Current Therapy 系列教科书所开创的一个特点。该系列教科书包括外科学、神经外科学、消化内科学等,其目的是对这些学科的经典教科书进行补充。经典的教科书具有最权威的内容,它们对某一领域疾病的体征、诊断、发病机制、病理生理和疾病过程进行了广泛的论述。但由于经典的教科书规模大,编撰所需的时间长、投入大,所以一般6~8年才修订一次。这样往往使得书中有关治疗的内容显得陈旧。诸如本书的新型教科书的出现大大缩短了旧版与修订版之间的时间,基本上可以实现每三年修订一次。这样一来,书中关于治疗的章节就能得到及时的更新,这对有经验的医师来说非常重要。这本由 Peter Mattei 博士主编的图书由多位作者完成,这样一本教课书正是为小儿外科医师提供的。如果你的目的是系统地学习一种疾病的发病过程、发病机制、病理生理、诊断或者是进行更加广泛的涉猎,Peter 博士的这本书并不能替代现有的几本优秀的小儿外科图书。然而,对于繁忙的医师来说,如果他们要快速地获取治疗某种疾病的最新技术,这本书肯定是首选。

本书包括了139章,由150位作者完成,其中大多数是美国作者,也有一些其他国家的作者。这些作者中既有护理医师、住院医师和主治医师,又有学科负责人和科室主任,都是各自撰写那一部分内容的专家,具有丰富的经验。章节之中并没有包括一种疾病的所有的治疗方法,但包含了领域内专家提出的一个治疗方案;在总结经验的基础上,这些专家发明了已经得到认可的某种疾病的治疗方法。本书的读者对象并没有包括学生。本书的内容没有包括基本的解剖、病理生理和诊断知识,所以本书的读者对象是普通外科的高年资住院医师、小儿外科主治医师和经验丰富的小儿外科主任医师,无论他们是从事科研还是临床工作。在本书每一章节的最后都附有一个"推荐阅读内容",其中包括

数篇与该章节相关的重要论文或文献,但并不是一个大量的针对性不强的文献 目录。"推荐阅读内容"可以使读者迅速直接地读到所在领域的重要文献。

我觉得《小儿外科指南》作为该系列教科书的第一本,几年之后将会有修订版本。在新的版本中如果某一章节的作者有变化,那么新的内容将被加在先前内容之后。儿科医师可以从新的版本中学习到另一个专家对一种疾病或临床情况的治疗建议。不断出现的《小儿外科指南》的新的版本和经典的小儿外科教科书将会大大开拓小儿外科学生和小儿外科医生的眼界,为他们提供最新的治疗信息,这对他们成为一个优秀称职的小儿外科医师是必不可少的。
