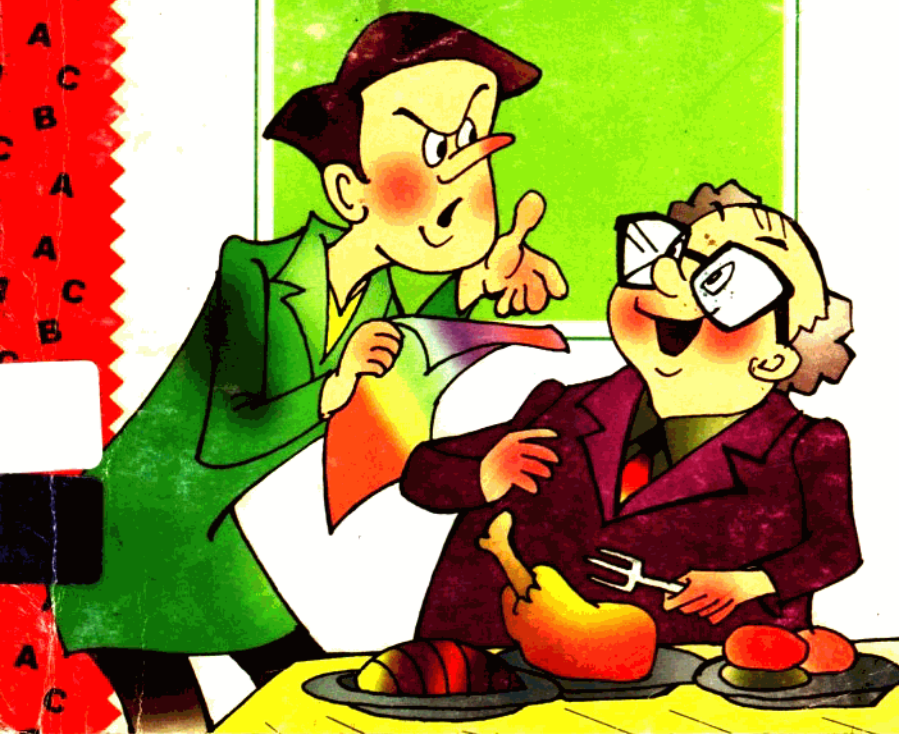

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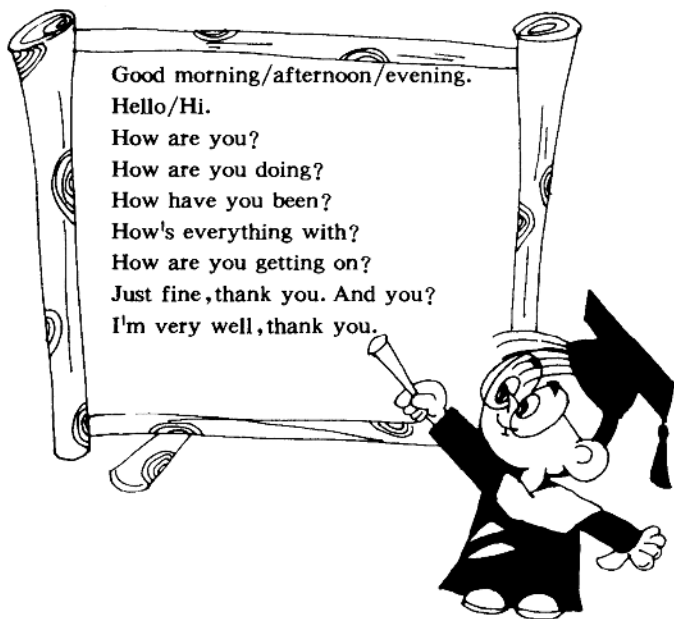
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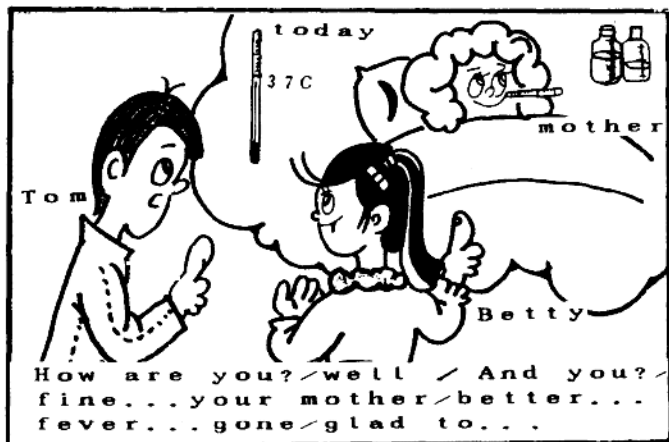

Tom :Hello,Betty,How are you?

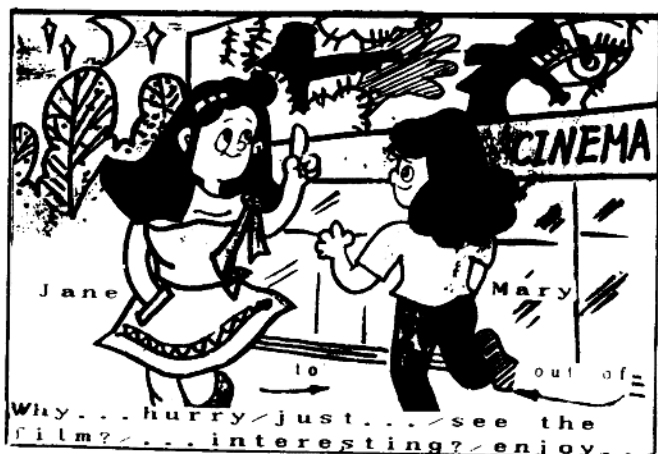
Betty :Quite well,Tom. And you?

Mary :Hi,Dick! Pleased to meet you.

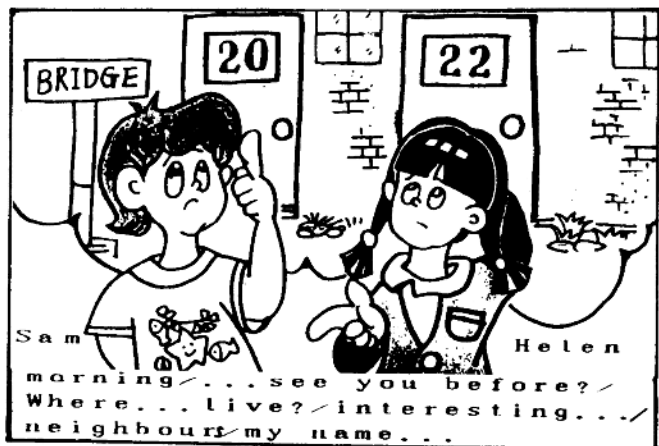
D :It's so nice to see you again.

H : I'm Helen Smith. How do you do?

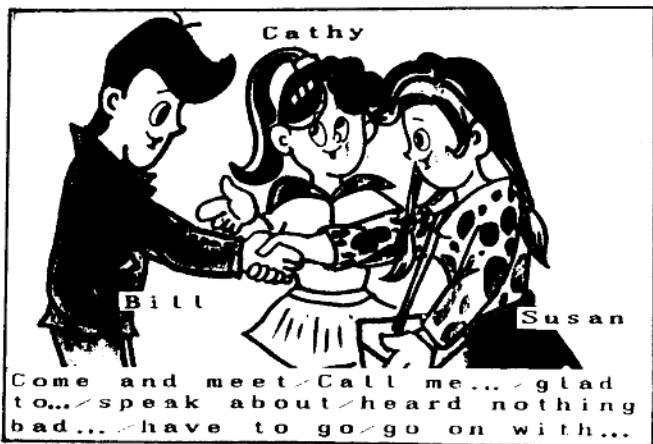

M :How do you do,Tom?

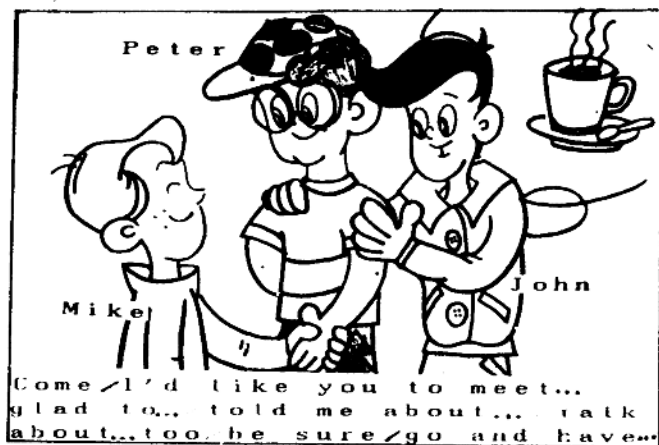
T :Jane and I study in the same class.

M : Really? John has talked about you too.

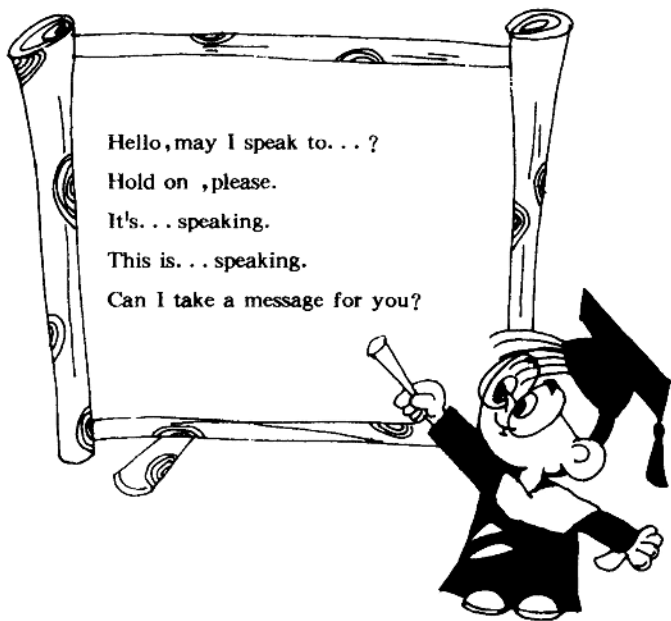
J : I'm sure we'll be good friends. Why don't we go and have a cup of tea together?
