前言

全面 标准 按照新大纲所列全部 5495 个单词的顺序,加注标准国际音标,根据高等教育出版社出版的《全国硕士研究生入学统一考试英语考试大纲(非英语专业)》,结合历年考试试题,给出全部词义和词组,方便考生读、写、记忆、背诵。
