#### 内容简介

本书是参考各种英语语法教程编写的练习册,主要是针对高职高编写的。本书适合于 A、B 级英语应用能力考试,专升本考试,大学四、六级英语水平考试,也可作为高等院校以及自学者使用的英语语法配套的练习材料。

本书配有答案和详解,既利于教师辅导,也利于学生自学使用,一定会受到读者的欢迎。

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#### 前言

为了加强高职高专学生的英语应用能力,本书全面、系统、由浅入深地组织编写,旨在帮助学生学习和掌握语法中的重点、难点、疑点和考点,是学习英语语法的良师益友。 编者根据英语教学实践中的长期积累,精心编选,使得本书内容丰富、编排科学、形式多样、语言规范。

本书由四部分组成:第一部分为专项语法练习,针对历年考题进行了科学分类,共十七个单元,每单元三至五个类型;第二部分为语法综合练习,共有五套语法综合练习题,题型新颖,贴近四、六级考试,着重考查学生的综合语言运用能力;第三部分为 A、B 级应用能力考试真题和四、六级考试真题;第四部分为练习和真题的答案及详解。

本书特点:分项练习,由浅入深,题型新颖,量大而广,主客观试题并章,有助于培养学生的英语语言表达能力和语言运用能力。

本书是各类英语语法教材及 A、B 级应用能力考试和四、六级英语考试的配套练习册, 适合高职高专院校、电大、成人院校的学生使用。

在编写过程中,参考了大量的四、六级真题和相关语法教材,在此我们对学界的前辈及同仁深表感谢。由于编者水平有限,书中难免有不当之处,恳请广大读者批评指正。
