前言

●为什么要编写这本书?

词汇是语言的基础,没有词语就没有句子,文章也就无从谈起。学习英语,背词汇又是老大难问题,这已经是老生常谈。问起学生:你如何背单词?大多数学生回答:还有什么办法,生背!

一日,一学生跑到我的办公室对我说:背单词太难了,你把单词录下来,我们听着背吧。我们几个教师听了很受启发,为什么不出版一本书,让学生背单词更轻松一些呢?

其实,背单词也是有方法的。研究机构做过测试表明,多感官配合的记忆效果相对于单一感官记忆效果要好得多,通俗一点儿讲,一边听一边看书,背单词的效果会更好。因此在这本书中我们把单词录到磁带中,让大家边听、边看、边背诵。

●这本书的最大特点。

利用零散的时间背单词、学英语是这本书的最大特点。 把单词录在磁带里,利用上学路上、在家收拾东西、 起床睡前洗漱等零散时间都可以听听磁带。这就是学习语 言过程中所说的"磨耳朵"。日久天长,听习惯了,听熟练 了,单词就自然印在了脑子里。

在书中,我们还列出了有关单词的常见句子、短语和固定搭配,学生可利用零散的时间看一看。在看的过程中并不强行要求记住,每天看一点儿,日积月累,也就记住了。

●如何使用这本书?

学生可灵活地使用这本书。可以准备好纸笔,边听磁带,边写单词。如果不愿意这样"正规"地学习,你可以一边放磁带,一边干别的不重要的事情。再有,你可以利用坐在公交车上的时间看看这本书,熟悉句子和短语。总之,利用闲散时间,多听听,多看看,最大限度地使用书和磁带,长久下去,对你的英语学习大有益处。

在编写的过程中,还有几位老师参加了编写工作,他们是:冯巍、蒋秀敏、刘敬霞、李远、徐红、苑海英、尹 秋林。我们在编写过程中难免会有疏漏之处,请读者指正。

最后,作为老师,我希望学生都有好的身体、好的心态、好的为人、好的成绩。
