A bit of rain and wind in summer can be nice. But bad storms are a bit different. Some of the worst storms are typhoons. Every year, about 80 typhoons hit different places around the world. The strongest ones are usually the Pacific Ocean and the South China Sea. Most happen in July, August and September.

Why? When lots of seawater gets hot in the summer sun, it evaporates into the air. This makes the air hotter, too. When the air gets warm enough, it starts to move higher up into the sky. Then, cooler air around it rushes in till the space that is left. Once the air gets warmer, it starts to move more quickly, making wind. The wind goes in circles, and it keeps moving higher in the sky. The warmer the air gets, the quicker the wind moves. And when the wind moves faster than 30 metres a second, a typhoon begins.

A typhoon has two parts. One is called the "eye". This is right in the middle of a typhoon and is calm. The eye of a typhoon can be about 40 kilometres wide. In the eye, the wind does not move so fast, and there are not many clouds in the eye. The other part of a typhoon is the wall of clouds around the eye. This is where the strongest winds and hardest rains are.

Typhoons are very dangerous. They blow away houses and cars. And they can also kill people! Typhoons' hard rains are bad for farmers' fields.

What to do when a typhoon hits

•Cover all windows and stay away from them. If you're told to go to a safer place, do so right away.

•Try to bring all of your things inside. Strong winds could even blow away your bike!

•Listen to the radio or TV for important information.

•Cut away parts of trees that can be broken off by wind to stop them from doing more damage.

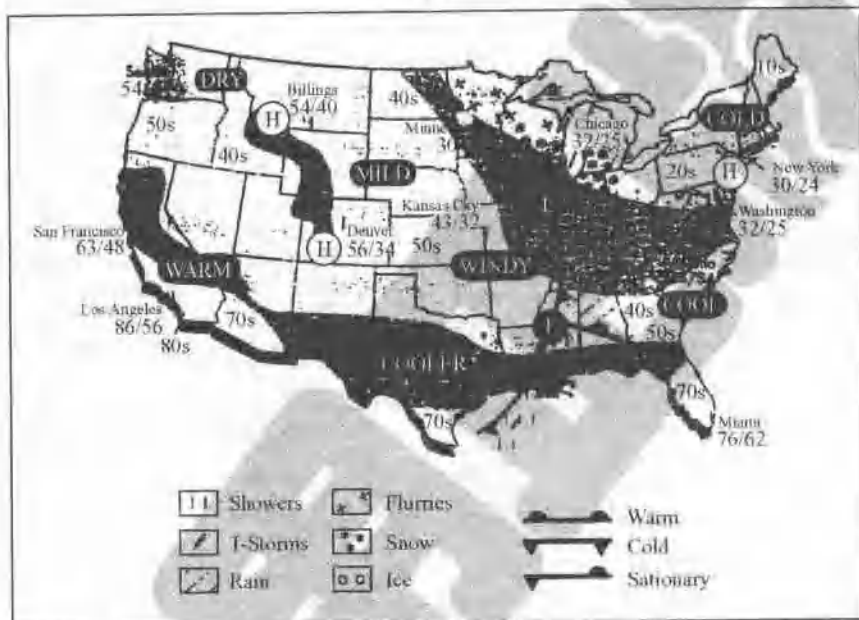

School kids today are getting more money. At one Shanghai school, 205 students got about 500,000 yuan in their red envelopes in total this year.

But parents worry that the kids don't know how to take care of the money by themselves. Zhang

Sen's mother likes the card. Zhang, a Junior 2 in Wuhan, has been asking for a computer for a long time, but his mother hasn't bought him one.

"We want him to use his card to save money for the computer step by step," she said. "If we buy everything he asks for, he would think that money comes too easily, and he won't work hard for it."

Experts say that understanding personal finance is important and should be done early.

"Those who start saving early will continue the habit when they grow up," said Wang Min, a financial expert in Wuhan. "It's better to teach kids how to fish rather than just feeding them fish."

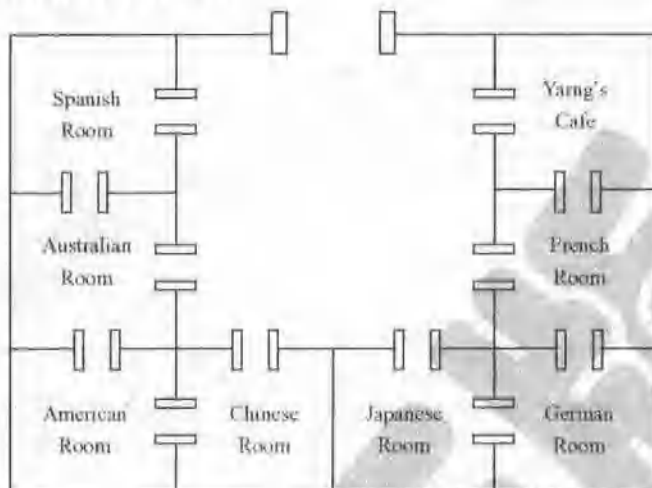
