1999年以后,新东方越来越大,如果我每天继续走进教室教书,新东方就会在缺乏管理和秩序的混乱中崩溃。为了让新东方有序地存在并发展,为了让新东方成为优秀人才的聚集地,我忍痛割爱地放弃了每天站在讲台上的痛快,进入了枯燥而琐碎的日常管理之中。转眼六年过去了,在这六年中,新东方得到了长足的发展,新学也长秀教师越来越多,有很多教师在英语教学尤其是英语词汇教学内已经远超过了我的水平。我感到欣慰,因为我的放弃,新自己亦有电视。我最大的愿望是有一天,当新东方中的英语词汇水平越来越低。我最大的愿望是有一天,当新东方时的英语词汇水平越来越低。我最大的愿望是有一天,当新东方时的英语词汇和严重,踏踏实实地可以不要,当时后,我能够重新踏踏实实地研究我所要对的节籍,并且踏踏实实地走进课堂,面对一张张可爱的笑脸,向他们讲述词汇的故事、学习的故事、生活的故事。那时候,我也许已经

白发苍苍,但面对无数向往未来的面孔,我一定会回忆起我自己的 无数青春往事,并再次点燃我自己的青春激情和火焰。

《英语词汇速记大全 1——词根+词缀记忆法》是我六年前的一部作品。当时我想写三到四部有关英语词汇记忆的书籍,其中第二本书《从熟悉的单词记生词》,在2000年时我已经在电脑中完成了,但不幸的是,有一次我的手提电脑掉到了地上,结果电脑和电脑中的文字全部被摧毁,同时被摧毁的还有我重新写书的勇气。后来我懂得了机器的不可靠,学会了随时把电脑中的文字拷贝到另一个硬盘上,但书还是没有写出来。我为自己的懒惰找了很多的理由,比如太忙啦,比如有更重要的事情啦,比如要陪很多人喝酒应酬啦,但最后发现永远丢失的不仅仅是作品,还有自己的成就感,最后把自己也给丢了,惟一留下的是反复出现在心头的遗憾。

也许这样的遗憾还要出现很多次,因为新东方还有很多事情没有做完,因为我个人生活中还有很多事情要用心去完善。但我知道时间不会等我,我也知道自己不能落在地球旋转速度的后面。因此,我会在未来的岁月里,挤出时间来继续我的研究工作。书籍是惟一能够表明我曾经努力的物证,书籍也是惟一能够化解我对自己期待的良药。一切都需要重新开始,我惟一需要的就是重新开始的勇气。

《英语词汇速记大全1——词根+词缀记忆法》是一个很好的开始。单词记忆是英语学习者的必经之路,我的任务是把这条路铺得更加平坦和科学一点。几经周折,于是大家手里就有了英语词汇速记大全系列,本书是这一系列的第三本《英语词汇速记大全3——同形近形比较法》。这本书有两大亮点:一是把同形单词中的不同释义分别列出,并以形象的记忆法联合记忆;二是把词形相近的单词加以比较记忆,使大家在短时间内就能记住一系列单词,可谓省时省力。
