前 言

高等学校英语应用能力口语考试是由全国英语应用能力考试委员会和各省、市教学主管部门共同举办的一项英语口语测试。此项考试采用全国统一命题、统一考试时间、统一评分标准、各省自行组织评分的形式进行。考试成绩合格者由英语应用能力考试委员会颁发口语考试证书。此项考试每年举行两次,其目的是促进大学英语教学改革,提高学生对英语的实际应用能力。

此项考试采用"人一机对话"的形式进行。根据多媒体教室的大小,每场考试可以有数十名考生同时参加。试题(包括其中指示说明)全部集成在考试专用的软件系统中。 考生根据系统提示或问题,直接以口头方式回答或叙述。考生的说话内容通过麦克风实时录制到考试系统中。

此项考试从三个方面进行评分:**内容、表达及语言。**采用总体记分的办法评定。成绩分为优秀与合格两个等级。

此项考试的主题包括:

A. 日常生活交际功能和主题

介绍、问候、感谢、致歉、道别、指点、接受、拒绝、问讯;天气、学习、爱好、饮食、健康、问路,等等。

B. 日常涉外交际功能和主题

宴请与迎送会、安排日程与活动、安排住宿、陪同外宾购物、游览、就诊,等等。

C. 一般涉外业务交际功能和主题

公司/工厂简介、产品介绍、市场推销、人员培训、业务洽谈、商品订购、付款方式、讨论价格、业务交流,等等。

沈阳工程学院从 2002 年开始就多次参与此项考试的试点工作,对其有着深入的研究和了解。为使考生更好地熟悉这项考试并进行充分的考前训练,沈阳工程学院刘然教授主持编写了这本《英语应用能力口语考试——临场模拟训练》。此书不仅能够提高考生的口语考试能力,更主要的是通过训练,可以极大地提高考生的英语口语水平。

本书由 25 套模拟试题组成,并配有由外籍英语专家配音录制的 MP3 光盘。考生在进行训练时,应在录音中所规定的时间内回答完问题。

本书尚有不足之处,敬请广大师生提出宝贵意见。
