





The authors are grateful to Mr. Patrick Quon from Canada and Mr. Chris Lack from Australia for their proofreading the English version.



中国古代经络图——手阳明大肠经 Ancient Chinese Meridian Picture - The Large Intestine Meridian of Hand-Yangming




中国古代经络图——足阳明胃经 Ancient Chinese Meridian Picture - The Stomach Meridian of Foot-Yangming




中国古代经络图——足太阴脾经 Ancient Chinese Meridian Picture - The Spleen Meridian of Foot-Taiyin




中国古代经络图——手少阴心经 Ancient Chinese Meridian Picture - The Heart Meridian of Hand-Shaoyin




中国古代经络图——手太阳小肠经 Ancient Chinese Meridian Picture - The Small Intestine Meridian of Hand-Taiyang
