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# 前 言

儿童早期双语能力发展的事实表明儿童早期在记忆母语的同时,也可轻易而举地记忆其他语言。在儿童学习语言的最佳时期,如果没有机会接受另一种语言信号的刺激,本来可以很容易掌握的东西,到成年后学习,却要付出巨大努力,而且学习效果不尽如意。

为了配合儿童早期学习英语,该教材根据儿童心理特征和日常生活特点编写了5本系列教材。该教材有以下4个特点:

1) 该教材所选内容、词汇,编写形式等便于儿童在日常生活中与父母、朋友对话,以便达到学以致用目的。

2) 循序渐进。第一册主要学习一些最基本的单词、句子;第二册、第三册是日常生活对话;第四册、第五册在前三册的基础上选编了儿童喜爱的童话、寓言故事。

3) 该教材配了精美图画以便引起儿童的好奇心,提高儿童的学习兴趣。

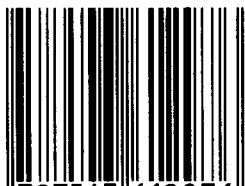
4) 该教材配有录音带以便于儿童学习时模仿,培养正确的语音、语调。

在学习使用该教材时应根据儿童年龄采用不同的方法。年龄小的能模仿发音、听懂就可以,不一定要让孩子记单词、记字母,以免影响孩子的学习兴趣。孩子有了一定的听说能力后,可以通过记单词、阅读来增强学习能力。

愿此书能成为幼儿园教师、家长们辅导孩子学习英语的最好助手。引发儿童学习英语的兴趣,并为以后的英语学习打下良好基础是此书的宗旨和编者的初衷和期望。

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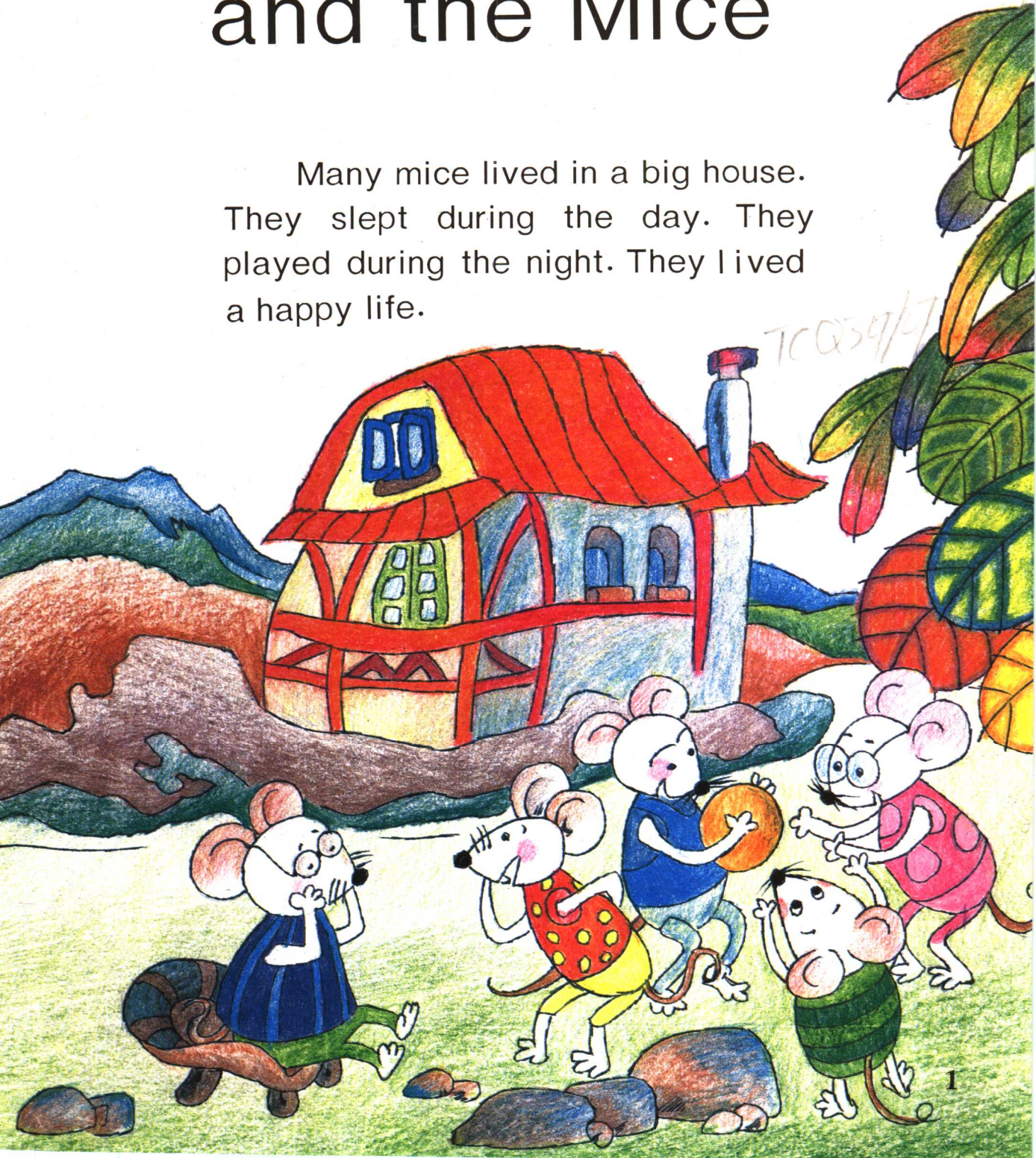


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# 1. The Cat and the Mice

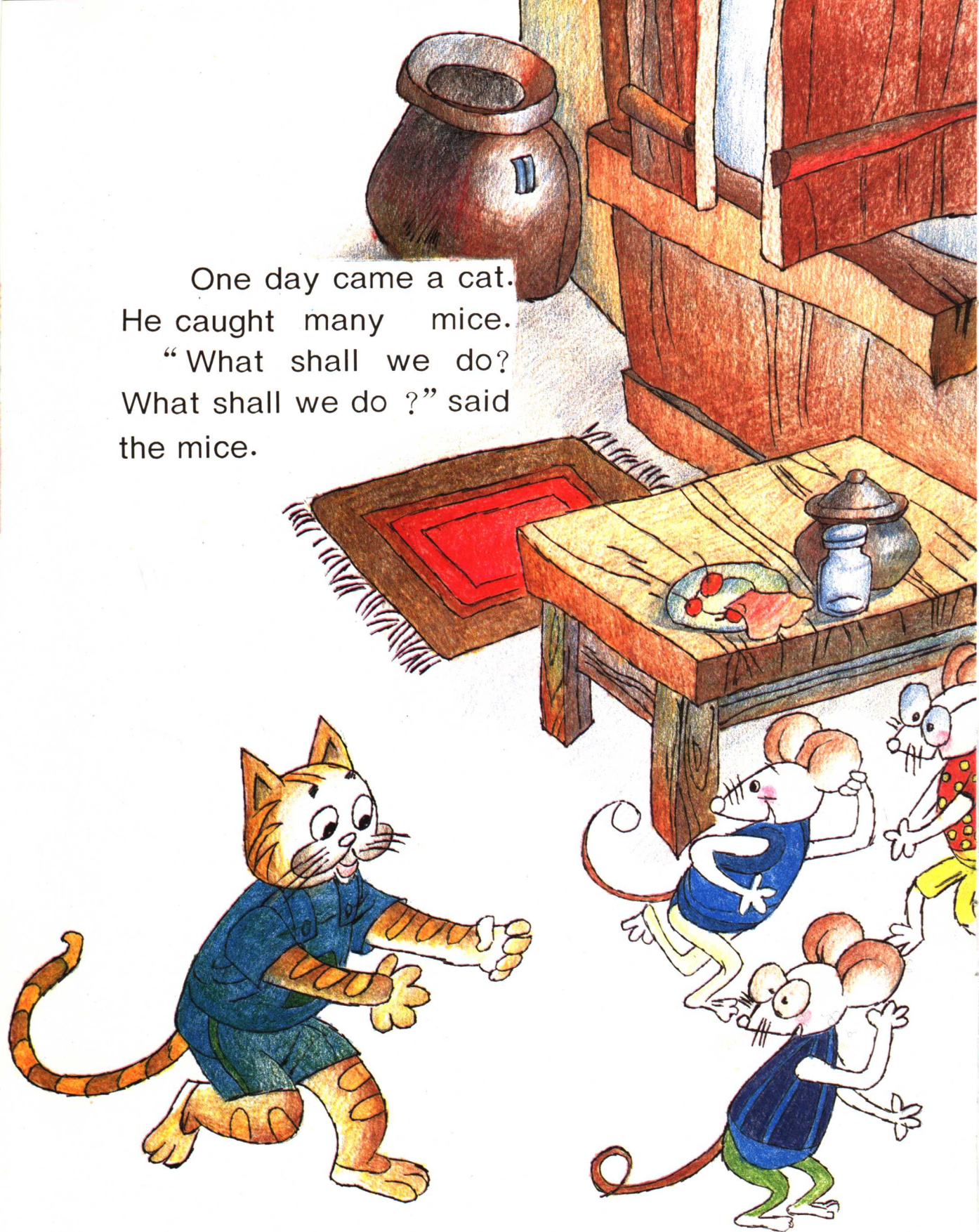
Many mice lived in a big house.

a happy life.





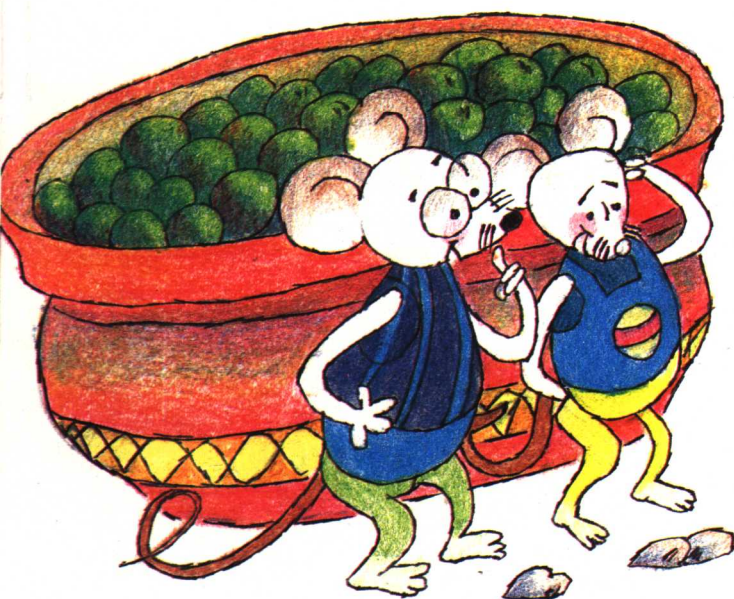
One day came a cat.

the mice.

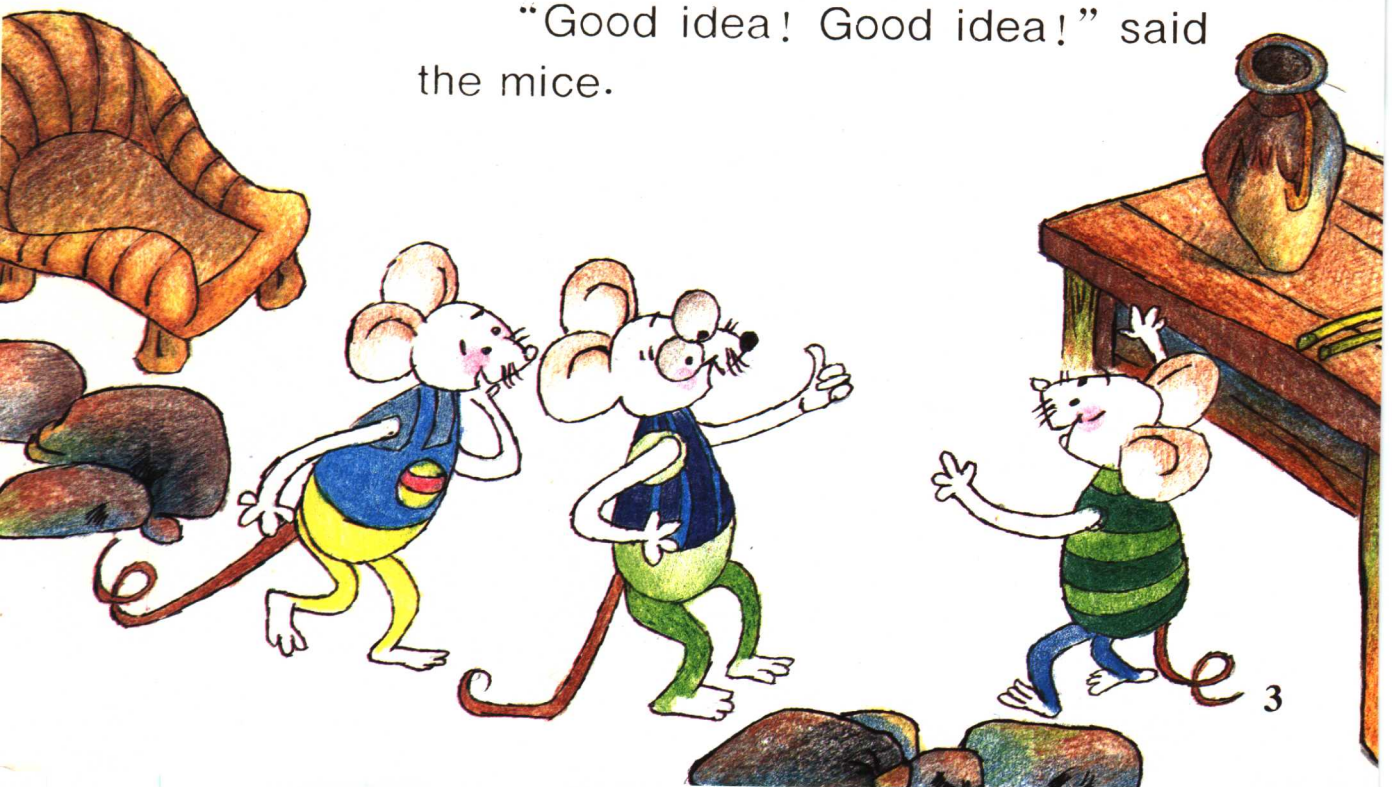




“Let’s put a bell on the cat’s neck,” said a little mouse, “When the cat comes, we can hear the bell.”



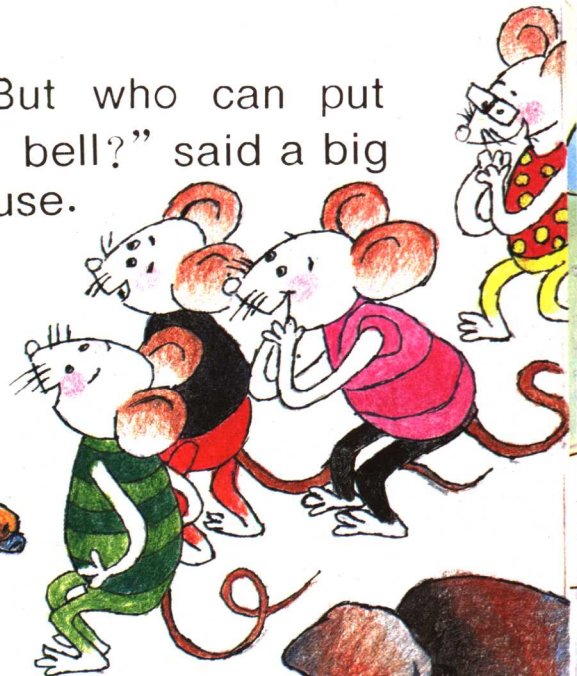
“Good idea! Good idea!” said the mice.



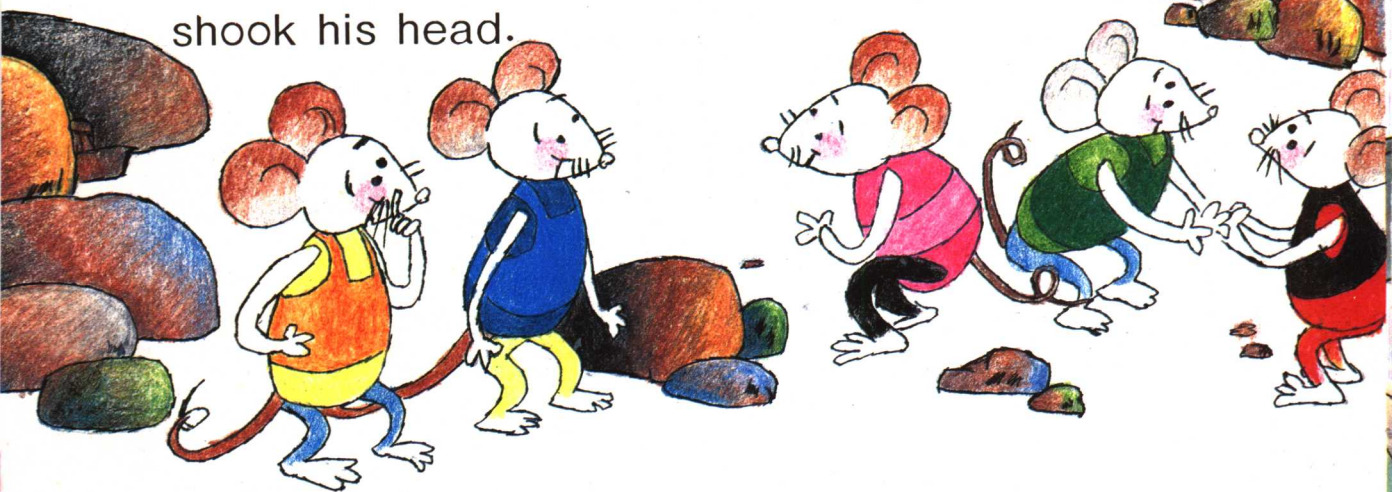




“But who can put the bell?” said a big mouse.

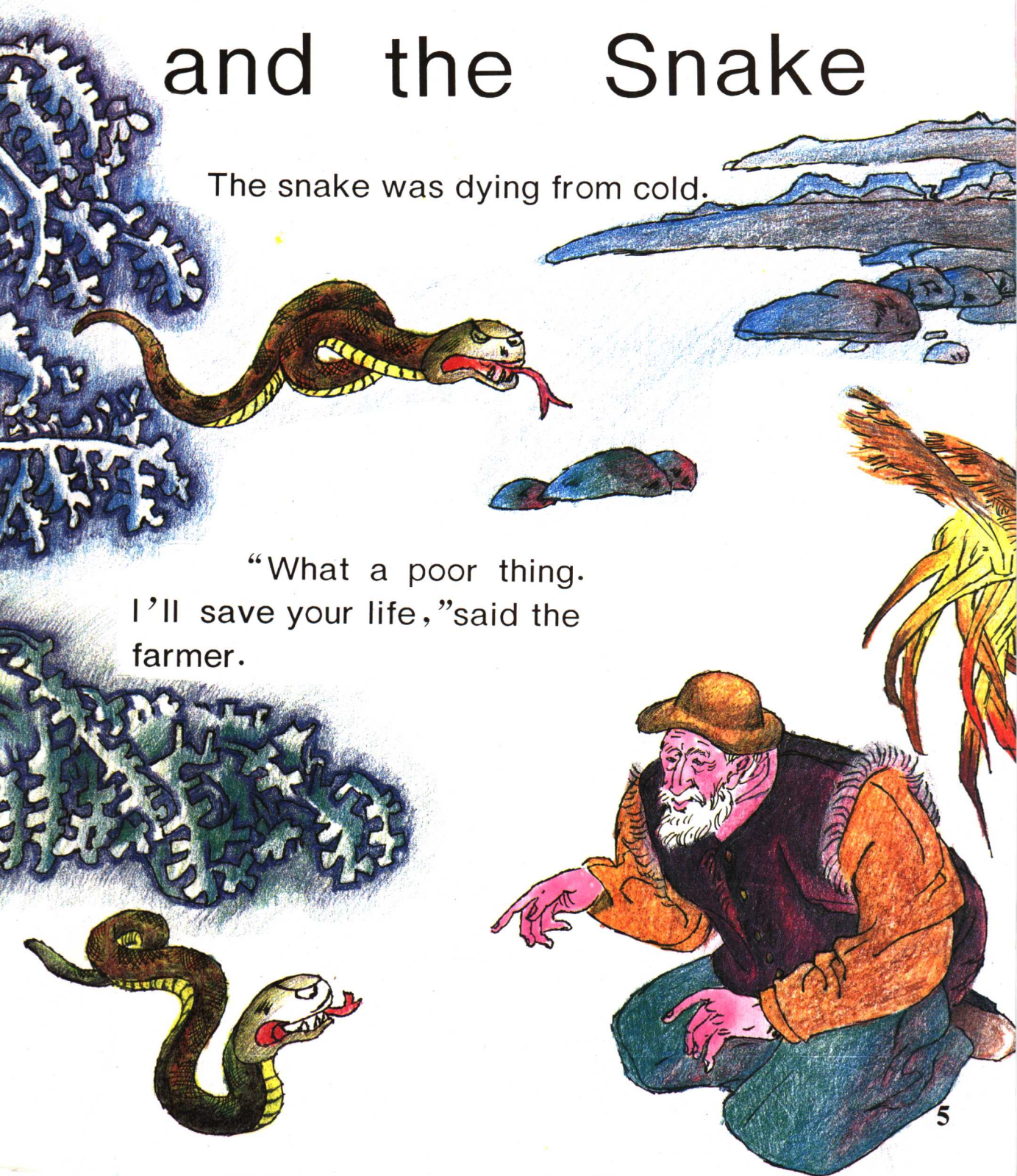

it under his coat.

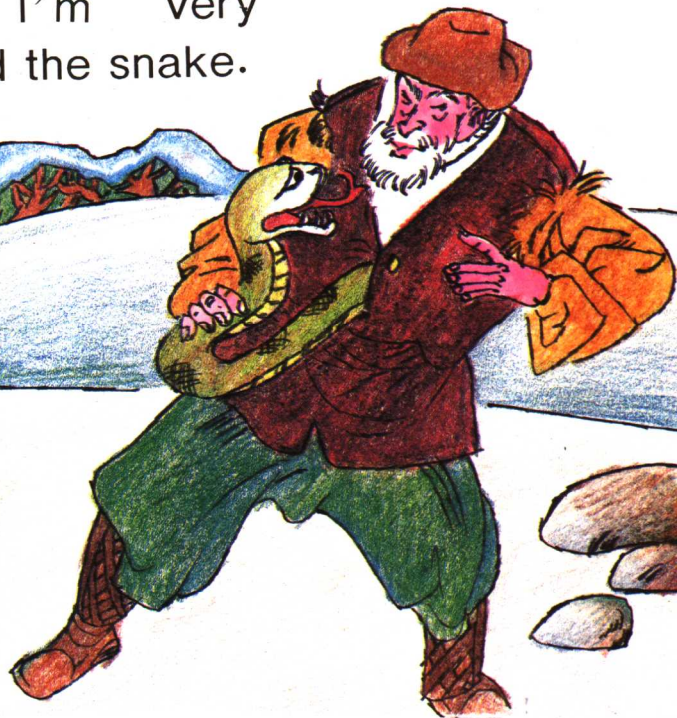


Soon the snake came to life.





“Thank you. But I’m very hungry. I’ll eat you!” said the snake.

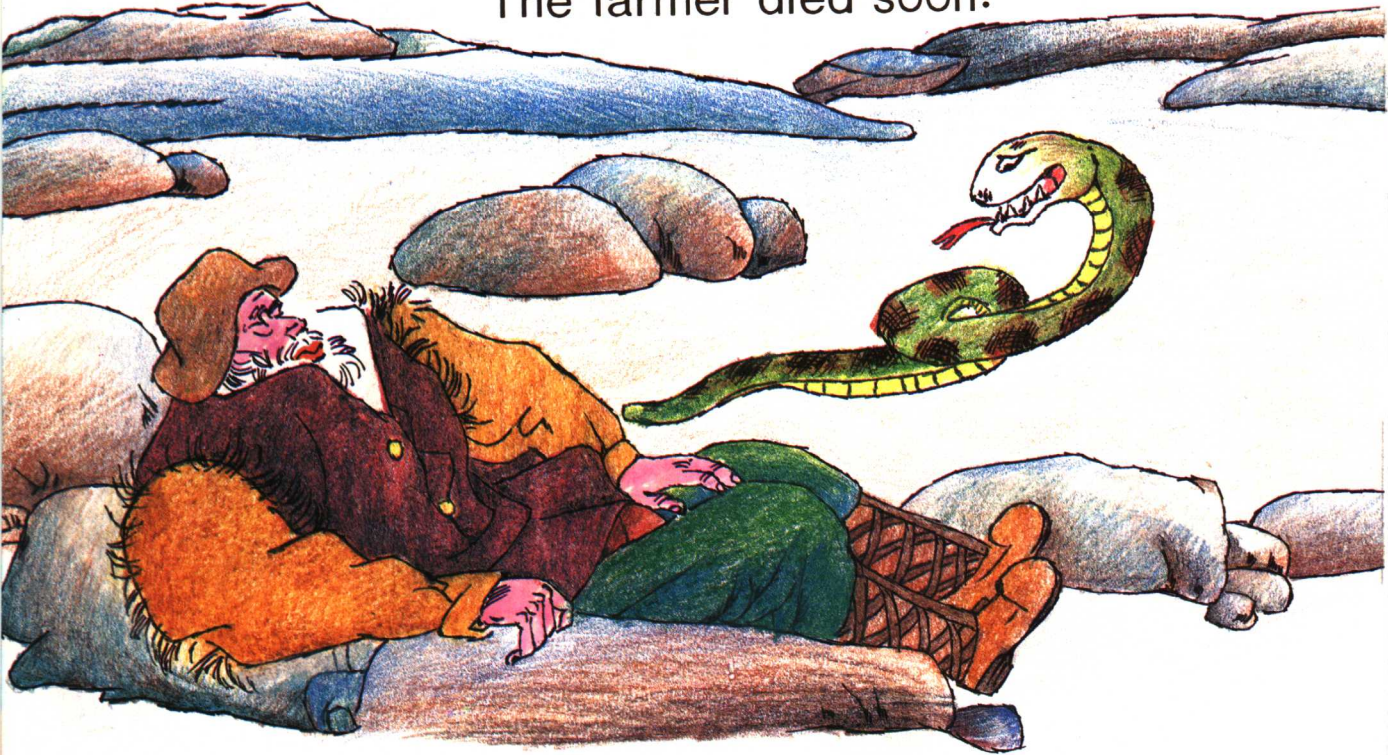


“No, you can’t do that!” the farmer was very angry.

The farmer died soon.



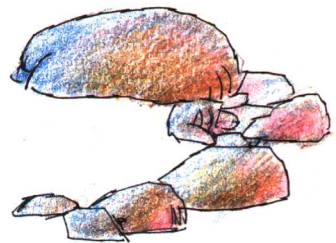

# 3. The Fox Stealing Grapes



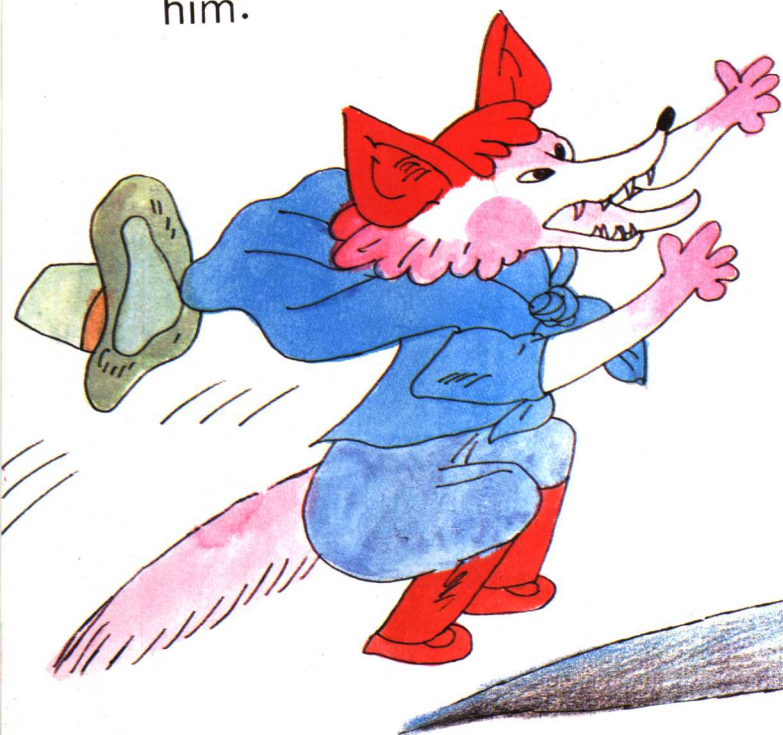
The bear planted his garden with many grapes. The grapes grew big and sweet.

The fox was lazy and greedy. He wanted to steal the lovely grapes.





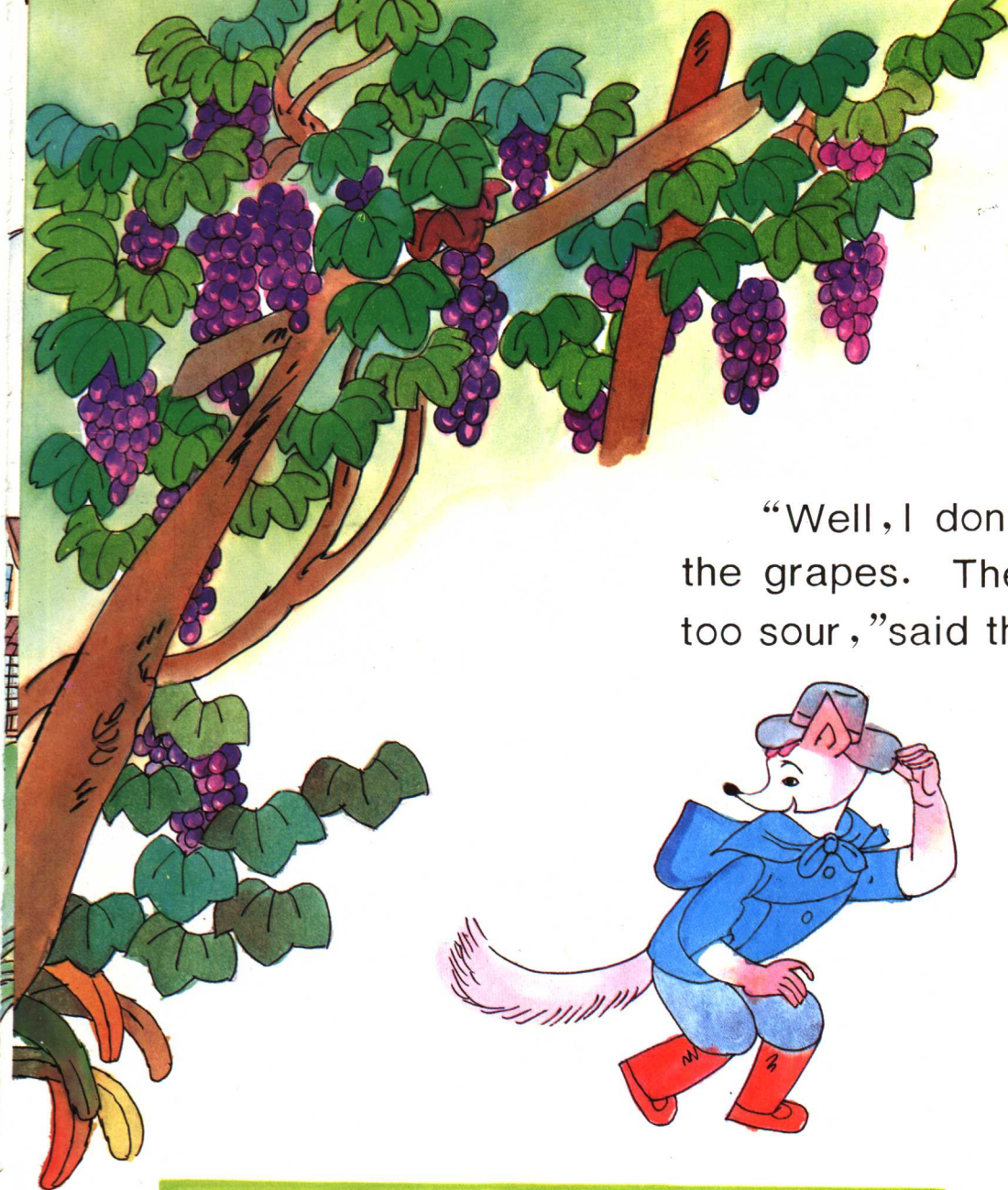
One day the fox stole
