Unit 8. Mark Twain

Mark Twain, who wrote the story we are going to read, traveled quite a lot, often because circumstances, usually financial circumstances forced him to. He was born in Florida, Missouri in 1835, and moved to Hannibal, Missouri with his family when he was about four years old. Most people think he was born in Hannibal. But that isn't true. After his father died when he was about twelve, Twain worked in Hannibal for a while and then left so he could earn more money. He worked for a while as a typesetter on various newspapers, and then got a job as a river pilot on the Mississippi. Twain loved this job, and many of his books show it. The river job didn't last, however, because of the outbreak of the civil war. Twain was in the confederate army for just two weeks, and then he and his whole company went west, to get away from the war and the army. In Nevada and California, Twain prospected for silver and gold without much luck, but did succeed as a writer. Once that happened, Twain traveled around the country giving lectures and earning enough money to go to Europe. Twain didn't travel much the last ten years of his life, and he didn't publish much either. Somehow his travels, even when forced, inspired his writings. Like many other popular writers, Twain derived much of the materials for his writing from the wealth and diversity of his own personal experiences.

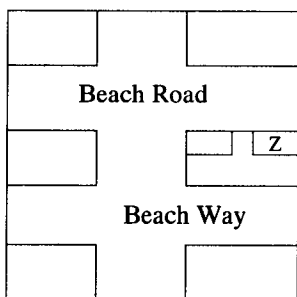

背景介绍

这首歌来自丹麦4人组合(现在3人) Michael Learns to Rock 的第6张大碟“Take Me to Your Heart”。大家对 Michael Learns to Rock 一定不会陌生, 他们的成名曲 That's Why (You Go Away) 一直在到处传唱。虽然乐队的名字中有 Rock, 但是他们一直坚持的却是抒情歌曲的路线, 不断感动着各位歌迷。比较符合亚洲人喜好的曲风使他们在亚洲远比他们在西方要受欢迎。这张2004年的全新专辑包括10首旋律优美、琅琅上口, 充满 MLTR 抒情风格的作品, 我们完全可以感受到他们对音乐的执着和诚意。特别值得推荐的是专辑同名主打歌曲 Take Me to Your Heart, 大家听了肯定会感到十分亲切, 因为这首歌是 MLTR 专为感谢中国歌迷一直以来对他们的喜爱和支持而特别翻唱香港天王张学友的名曲《吻别》, 同时也进行了一些改编, 使之更符合 MLTR 的风格。我们可以听到, MLTR 的版本中少了一份哀怨, 多了几分深情, 编排清新动听, 歌词浅显易懂, 因此 DJ Leo 特别向大家推荐, 是西方流行音乐爱好者和英语学习者都不可错过的好歌, 让我们一起再一次感受 MLTR 的真情演绎。

要点精讲

(1) hide from... 这里的意思是“躲避起来不受……损害/伤害; 躲开……”之义, 这里是介词 from 的一个重要用法, 表示“不受……危害/影响; 避开”。

It is difficult for stars to hide from paparazzi. 明星们要躲开“狗仔队”很困难。
You are always hiding from the truth. 你总是不肯面对真相。

包含这个意义的 from 的常用词组还有:

protect sb./sth. from... 保护……不受……的危害

I will protect you from all around you. 我会保护你不受周围一切的伤害。(Phil Collins "You'll Be in My Heart")

shelter (sb. / sth.) from... 遮蔽/掩护……不受……的危害/影响

I will keep you safe and strong, and shelter from the storm. 我会好好保护你, 为你遮蔽风雨。(Boyzone "No Matter What")

be free from... 不受……(影响, 危害等)

The more expensive kind of antique shop where rare objects are beautifully displayed in glass cases to keep them free from dust is usually a forbidding place. 高档一些的古玩店为了防尘把货品好看地陈列在玻璃柜中, 往往让人望而却步。(Lesson 34, New Concept English Book 3)

He, may never be sure where the next meal is coming from, but he is free from the thousands of anxieties which afflict other people. 他(流浪汉)可能不知道下顿饭从何而来, 但他不像其他人那样受到数不胜数的烦心事的折磨。(Lesson 27, New Concept English Book 3)

另外请注意, 本句歌词中的 hide 作不及物动词用, 表示“躲避, 藏身”, hide 也可以当作及物动词来用, 含义是“将……隐藏”, 因此要注意区别 hide from... 和 hide... from... 两个词组, 后者表示“将……隐藏/掩盖起来不让……看见/发现”, 例如:

The president hid the truth from the people. 总统向人民隐瞒了真相。

If the landscape is hidden from view, you can enjoy the extraordinary sight of unbroken cloud plains that stretch out for miles before you, while the sun shines brilliantly in a clear sky. 如果地面上的景色被遮住了, 可以欣赏展现在面前的延绵数里的云海, 同时阳光灿烂, 天空澄清。(Lesson 44, New Concept English Book 3)

- (2) let go 放开, 放手, 松开。经常与 of 搭配
I won't let go. 我不放手。
Let go of me! 放开我!

- (3) heart beat = heartbeat 心跳。beat n.&v. 跳动, 搏动

Doesn’t matter. = It doesn’t matter.
- (6) wonder n. 奇迹, 奇妙的事情 (可数)

- (7) now or never 字面的意思是“要么现在, 要么就永远都没机会了”, 相当于中文的成语“机不可失, 时不再来”。

- (11) wanna = want to 的口语形式, 后面跟动词原形
