《新课标英语阅读练习》编委会

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编写说明

英语阅读能力是构成英语语言交际能力的最重要的组成部分，在各种英语考试中逾 70% 的成绩取决于英语阅读水平。新的国家《英语课程标准》（即“新课标”）对中学生的阅读目标和阅读量都提出了更高的要求，这是必然的。为此，我们紧密结合“新课标”的要求，编写了《新课标英语阅读练习》系列丛书，以求适合各阶段学生的阅读要求，帮助学生在语言技能、语言知识、学习策略和文化意识等方面达到“新课标”的培养目标。

在编写过程中，我们力求突出如下特点：1. 符合各阶段学生的学习需求。在初三和高三阶段，应试的要求比较高，书中阅读素材的选取与测试题型的设置尽量做到具有实战性。而对于其他年级，学生更需注重学习过程，通过书中较长的经典原文阅读，有利于扎实地训练泛读的策略与技巧。2. 注重系统地培养学生良好的阅读习惯。阅读材料按照词汇、语法现象和题材等进行了科学的分级，使学生能够循序渐进，拾级而上。练习题中除了传统题型之外，还纳入了一些趣味题，甚至开放式的讨论题。丛书的这些举措旨在启发读者培养良好、积极的阅读习惯，而不是单纯为了应付测试。

本书在编写过程中得到了诸多著名英语教育专家和有经验的一线教师的支持，在此表示感谢。限于时间等原因，书中难免有不足之处，欢迎批评指正。

Roddy saw that the cabins on “C” and “D” decks weren’t as beautiful as the cabins on “A” and “B” decks. The people were poorer³ here.



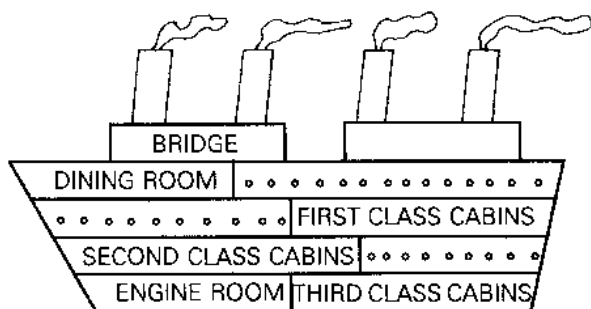
